Transforming Mason's Field into a beautiful Wildflower Meadow

Mason's Field

This is the latest phase in transforming Mason's Field (a former playing field) into a wildflower meadow. We have flowers such as Meadowsweet, Lady's Smock and Field Woodrush to plant. There are six hundred plant plugs and we need your help. With Spring just around the corner we need to plant them now to benefit from the start of the growing season. The ground will have been prepared in advance so it will be much easier to lay them in !

Green Lane

One of the projects in Mason's Field that BHCG has worked very hard at over a number of years is the clearing and restoration of this ancient trackway which goes back to medieval times. Only a small fragment remains. For hundreds of years farmers use to herd their animals along this track as they moved them between fields. BHCG thinks that it is important to retain features from the past as an integral part of the nature reserve. It enables us to understand how the landscape of Fryent Country Park has evolved and changed over time.

The John Muir Award

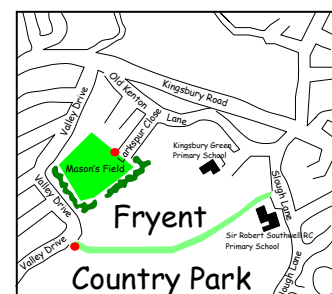
We made a good start to the John Muir Award on Saturday the 22nd of February. Our young conservationists tackled Hell Lane removing overhanging branches and vegetation which was blocking this ancient pathway. It was demanding work in tricky conditions but the team stuck at it, all the time improving their skills using a variety of different tools. **JM Award members are welcome to participate in the planting of wildflowers on the 23rd and add an hour or two towards their certificate!**
