You may have noticed that in the summer we started stocking 2 red, 2 white, a rosé and a Prosecco from an independent wholesaler in South Molton. They are good wines, not found in the big supermarkets and are for sale at very reasonable prices:

Cotes du Rhone, Les Trois Couronnes (red) – Light, pure and smooth but with some lively fruit from the Grenache/Syrah blend. £7.50

Malbec, Trivento (red) – Deep ruby colour with spiced plum and red berry fruit. Dense and velvety, robust but rounded and easy. £7.20

Sauvignon, Casa Rivas (white) – A fruit-forward nose and tropical flavours. From quartz-rich vineyards cooled by Pacific breezes. £6.90

Pinot Grigio, Vivolo di Sasso (white) – Easy, fresh all-rounder with gentle elderflower and lemon fruit. \pounds 7.20

White Zinfandel, Cloudburst (rosé) – Soft and sweetly-fruited rosé from California. Gentle hints of strawberry and redcurrant. £6.99

Prosecco, Botter – Gentle fizz from Venice. A beautifully delicate wine, soft and light. Semi-sparkling. £8.30
