ACCESS AND AMENITY STATEMENT**

St Bartholomew, Great Gransden is open to all. We welcome everyone to our church buildings. The Church is unlocked every day between 9am and 5pm (or dusk when this is earlier). No charge is made for admission.

Parking for the disabled and other visitors is available outside the churchyard in Church Street. A level path then leads to the church door. There are three steps down into the church building from the main door. During services and events there are always sidespersons available to assist anyone who needs it and a wheelchair ramp can be provided. There is a small kitchen area and disabled toilet available under the tower.

The seating in the nave of the Church itself is of wooden pews. The main aisle is of sufficient width to allow wheelchairs to be placed at the end of a row of pews. The Church is fitted with an induction loop system for the benefit of hearing aid users. A public address system is used for all services.

The church is also open in the evenings for concerts and other events from time to time. Access assistance is always provided at these events.
