### **New Web Site**

Generally more photos were wanted. So we have put them on. Apart from the walks, this is the most popular page on the site.

Maps of starting points were wanted. Starting points are now linked to the grid reference, just a click away. Walks are listed monthly, with a printable version. Where possible photos and other information about the walk are linked in too.

Forthcoming events have their own page, with more details. We also have a news page.

To support the site we have introduced an e-mail distribution group. This allows members who ask to be included, to receive e-mail notifying changes to the walk programme or other significant events, such as the publication of a new programme.
