# Survival Skills

Three Scouts from Swindon Village (Jakub Kubinak. Daniel Mitchell and Joshua Williams) and two of our former Scouts (William Lancaster & Oliver Smith) took part in the County organised Survival Skills weekend held up in woods near Duntisbourne Abbots over the last bank holiday weekend. They joined around 100 Scouts and Explorers from across Gloucestershire, Hampshire & Greater London who came to take part in one of the most challenging weekends that you can have as a Scout. This course took them through a real "Bear Grylls" style survival challenge and after several hours of training & instruction, with a knife as their only tool, they set about their survival exercise. This included building a shelter out of natural materials, foraging for wild food (including eating nettles) and preparing & then cooking rabbits over a camp fire without utensils. William and Oliver were back for their third year on Survival Skills and were taking part in the "Advanced Survival" course – which involves even less equipment and no sleeping bag for the weekend ! Needless to say - they all came home very tired and in need of a good bath – but happy and wiser for the experience and thrilled with their achievements ! Congratulations & well done lads.

### Scout Activate Camp - Kidderminster

Just four Scouts from Swindon Village took part in this activity camp based at Rhydd Covert Scout Camp Site – right next door to the West Midland Safari Park in Worcestershire. This is a beautiful woodland campsite with small grass clearings for camping and we were blessed with gorgeous weather throughout the weekend. On site the Scouts tackled: Climbing, Abseiling, Air Rifles & Archery. Off site - two had a flight in a light aircraft right over the camp site and the safari park, one went caving in the Forest of Dean while others went off mountain biking around the local area. Water activities included Kayaking, Canoeing,

Rafting, and Power Boating. This was an excellent weekend with quality activities and instructors that we hope to repeat next year.
