



MIXED TRIPLES SUMMER (OUTSIDE) FRIDAY LEAGUE

RULES

This Competition is for 12 Mixed Triples teams.

Teams will consist of 4 players -3 to play each match. With as equal a number of games as possible throughout the competition. (Recommended 3 players play in 8 games, Skips play in 9 games.)

Competition will run for 11 Fridays between 10th May and 2nd August 2019

1. FORMATION

The League will consist of twelve teams with three players (chosen from their team of 4) each using three woods for a match of 18 ends.

W.B.A RULES

Play will be conducted in accordance with the W.B.A Rules but in the event of conflict between the W.B.A rules and those listed below the latter shall prevail.

3. ADJUDICATION

Disputes shall be notified to the organisers for adjudication and their decision must be considered final.

4. MATCH POINTS

Two points will be awarded to the winners of each match and one point to both teams in the event of a draw. If necessary, shot difference will be used to determine league positions.

5. <u>FIXTURES</u>

Matches shall generally be played on Friday evenings commencing at the times listed and in accordance with the Fixture List attached. If possible, in the event of inclement weather we would hope to re-arrange the fixture list. If any team cannot play on the re-arranged day, we would ask that all such matches be re-arranged and played prior to the next Friday fixture date. In this connection the challenging team (i.e. first named) will offer their opponents a minimum of three alternative dates/times to play the postponed match. If either the challengers or their opponents are unable to complete the postponed match by the next Friday fixture date the offending team shall forfeit the match and the other team will be awarded two points and a shot difference of +5.

6. SUBSTITUTION OF PLAYERS

If an originally selected player is not available to play, he/she may be substituted with a "stand-in". The organisers shall be responsible for arranging "stand-ins" as required and for ensuring a full **mixed** team of three players for each match. **A "stand-in" may not act as Skip and can only be used once during the duration of the league.** If a team is unable to enter a match with a full mixed team of three players the offending team shall forfeit the match and their opponents will be awarded two points and a shot difference of +5.

7 SCORE CARDS

The Skip of **EACH** team shall prepare a score card and complete the score card for each match. On completion of the match each score card is to be signed by both skips before being handed in.

8. GREEN FEES

The Skip of each team is required to collect the £2.50 green fee from the members of his team and pass it to one of the organisers no later than 15 minutes before the scheduled start of the game. The £2.50 Entry Fee will be collected before the start of the first match.

9. FIRST TO BOWL

The two Skips shall toss a coin to decide which team bowls first.

10. TRIAL ENDS

There will be no Trial Ends.

11. <u>LATE START</u>

If a team is unable to field a full team of three players within fifteen minutes after the specified starting time shown in the Fixture List, the offending team shall forfeit the match and Rule 6 above shall apply.

12. DRESS CODE

WHITES. Skirts or Trousers for Ladies.
