5. **RCT Band Concert.** The Band will be performing in the Band Stand, Princes Gardens, opposite the Princes Hall, Aldershot on Saturday 13th July 1000 -1200 hours. The concert is free and open to everyone. Branch Standard Bearers are invited to parade their Standards, details to follow.

6. **The Dinner/Dance** is open to all members of the Association and their guests. Tickets will cost £10.00 each. Please use the attached form to submit Branch bids with payment.

7. **The Church Service** will take place in the Corps Church of St Michael & St George, The Cathedral Church of The Bishopric to the Forces. Car parking at the Church is limited, but if necessary please use the car park on the other side of the canal. (200 metres from the Church).

8. **Standard Bearers** are requested to parade on the steps leading into the Church at 1030 hours. The Standards will be presented to the Chaplain at the Altar at the beginning of the Service. Following the Sermon the Standards will be paraded in the Sanctuary, where the bearers remain until the end of the Service. On the conclusion of the Service, the Standards will march out ahead of the Chaplain, and form up on the steps of the church as the congregation leaves the church.
