**“Family Systems and Coping with Addictions”
Dr Ana Draper**



Cost: £45

Trainer: Dr Ana Draper is a highly specialist systemic psychotherapist who has worked in the NHS for many years. She has also worked for Non-Governmental Organisations and undertaken research used to support the development of therapeutic services within the NHS. She has been published by NICE as clinically excellent and is currently the project lead for Unaccompanied Minors Seeking Asylum in Kent. She has worked with people who have experienced addiction both individually and with the whole family.

Details: Ana is delighted to be facilitating a training day in which those who attend can participate in the learning process, can explore new ideas and ways of working and can understand the clinical dilemmas faced by both the addicted and their families.

**“Childhood Issues that impact Adult Life”
Miranda Marsh**

Trainer: Miranda Marsh is an Integrative Child Psychotherapist (UKCP registered) and supervisor, working in schools and in private practice. Before moving the focus of her practice to working with children, young people and their families, Miranda was a Counsellor working with adults and will bring her combined experience of working with both adults and children to her training day.

Details: This interactive day will explore the relationship between childhood issues and adult life and the implications of this for therapeutic practice. In particular, it will look at some of the research that links childhood issues and adult life, supporting this research with reference to neuroscience, attachment theory and research around childhood trauma. It will encourage practitioners to reflect on the impact of their own childhood experiences on their practice and to think about how an understanding of the relationship between childhood issues and adult life can be integrated into counselling practice.

**“Borderline Personality Disorder”
Dr Chris Andrew**

Trainer: Chris Andrew was a Consultant Psychiatrist/Psychotherapist in the NHS, and has worked for many years in Christian private practice. He is also a Director of Deep Release and Barnabas Counselling Training.

Details: He will offer a therapeutic model for understanding and working with Borderline Personality Disorder, drawing from a psycho-educative model. This helps explain to both therapists and clients the neuroscientific and traumatic basis of BPD. Out of this explanatory model he will share creative, holistic therapeutic strategies for addressing this distressing condition.

Both therapists and clients have found this model very helpful in understanding what can be a very difficult condition to manage. Come prepared for a lively and highly interactive training day.

Trainer: Olwen Kelly was appointed Director of Swindon Women’s Aid in 2012. Leading the organisation through a time of significant development and change, she is also a passionate advocate for domestic abuse victims and to ending violence against women. She was formally Head of Community Safety and Drugs at South Gloucestershire Council and a South West Regional Crime and Drugs Advisor for the Home Office. She commenced her career in the Civil Service and spent 17 years working in a variety of central Government departments including the Department for Education and Employment, Office for the Deputy Prime Minister and Home Office.

"Loss, Bereavement and Grief – in a Wider Context" - Sue and Chris Monckton-Rickett

Trainers: Sue and Chris are ACC Registered Accredited Counsellors and Regional Trainers for ACC's Pastoral Care UK arm. Sue is also ACC Vice Chair. They run WINGS (Wholeness In God's Son), promoting wholeness and healing for individuals, families and communities, through counselling, pastoral care, prayer ministry, retreat leading and conference speaking.

Details: Everyone experiences losses and resulting times of grief, as an inevitable part of life. How well we journey and accompany others through grief can make all the difference. There are no quick fixes. An African saying states "There is no way out of the desert except through it." We will explore the nature of loss and the purpose of grief: its emotional, physical and spiritual effects. We will examine some specific types of grief – anticipatory, disenfranchised, multiple losses, other complicated forms, children and grief and much more. We will look at ways of working with people in grief, from counselling/therapeutic, pastoral and other caring role perspectives, learning from each other's experiences.

**"Working with Blocked Anger"
Pauline Andrew**

Trainer: Pauline Andrew has an MA in Counselling and Psychotherapy and over 20 years practice experience. She is a Director of Deep Release and Managing Director of Barnabas Counselling Training where she teaches students to Diploma level. She also teaches the Diploma in Counselling Supervision and the new Level 5 Certificate in Integrating Creative Interventions.

Details: This lively, interactive training day will look at how blocked anger presents itself in the counselling room. Counsellors and pastoral workers will also be challenged to look at their own relationship with anger and Pauline will address how early in life we learn to block anger's energy, leading to physical and emotional ill health. The workshop will offer a number of creative interventions for working with anger.
