Saturday 7th September 2019 DEMONSTRATION by Rob Wareing 'Pastel Portrait'



Rob has painted numerous portraits of people of all nationalities and received many commissions to paint dignitaries, CEOs and their spouses and children in countries such as the USA, Mauritius, Botswana, South Africa & the UK. He has also given live portrait demonstrations on TV shows in the USA, Mauritius & South Africa. More recently he has gained a considerable following on YouTube with his instructional videos and he is also a regular contributor to 'The Artist' magazine.



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Saturday 5th October 2019 DEMONSTRATION by Oliver Pyle 'Watercolour Reflections'



Oliver has established himself as a successful landscape artist, predominantly focusing on the United Kingdom which he considers to be a rich source of inspiration. He was Artist in Residence for Sussex Life magazine in 2018 and is represented by Forest Gallery in Petworth, Sussex.

Saturday 12th October 2019 WORKSHOP with Bridget Woods 'Watercolour Life Painting'



Bridget Woods is an internationally acclaimed artist who specialises in life drawing and watercolour and is an inspiring teacher, known for her approachable style. She has held over 50 solo exhibitions and shown at the Royal Institute of Painters in Watercolour and the Royal Watercolour Society. Her main aim is to convey feeling and atmosphere through the unique 'alchemy' of transparent watercolour. She has written: 'Life Drawing - a Journey to Self-Expression' (2003), 'Life drawing - Techniques in Action' (Double DVD presented by author, 2007).

Saturday 2nd November 2019 DEMONSTRATION by Mark Warner 'Landscape or seascape'



Mark is an artist based in Shropshire. Sketching is at the heart of his work and it is integral to the development of a piece, many times forming part of the painting itself. He uses colour to interpret the light and weather conditions and often works directly in the field (literally on many occasions!) from sketches created outside as well as notes and photographs taken on location then developed back in the studio. He was the winner of the Qube Arts Open People's Choice Prize

Saturday 23rd November 2019 **NEW** WORKSHOP by Ronnie Ireland, 'Planning a painting and working from photographs'.

Ronnie held an excellent critique of members work last year and opened our Annual Exhibition in August, judging the three Awards of Merit. His guidance on how to plan and work from photographs should be fascinating and informative. Saturday 7th December 2019 DEMONSTRATION by Trevor Waugh 'Flower painting in oil'



Trevor studied at the Slade School of Fine Art then spent several years as an illustrator before returning to painting. He paints and exhibits at his studio in Heywood, Wiltshire and also runs watercolour and oil painting classes in the UK and abroad. His book 'Winning with Watercolour' has become a top-selling title and he followed this with 'You Can Paint Flowers in Watercolour' and 'You Can Paint Animals in Watercolour'.

TALK by Chris Christoforou 'It's a Jungle Out There - Art

His enthusiasm for watercolour painting is infectious and inspired as he constantly searches for new and exciting ways to render his subject.

Saturday 7th March 2020 DEMONSTRATION by Hilary Dancer 'Acrylic Landscape'



Hilary is a local contemporary artist working in acrylic, oil & mixed media. She uses a vibrant palette to produce a variety of impressionistic, almost abstract paintings, but is perhaps best known for her romantic figures & atmospheric cityscapes. Hilary works from her studio in Hampshire and her work can also be seen at the "The Frame" gallery in Odiham.

Saturday 4th July 2020 (AGM) DEMONSTRATION by Paul Oakley 'Oil Landscape'



Following the AGM and buffet lunch there will be the now traditional demonstration, which in 2020 will be by Paul Oakley. He is a self-taught artist living and working in Wiltshire who specialises in oil painting. Paul is predominantly a landscape artist and developed his painting style through studying the works of artists such as Edward Seago and his contemporaries. He enjoys being out in the elements capturing a moment in the landscape

as well as painting in his studio, which is a traditional Shepherd's Hut.
