

# Humpty Dumpty's Wall Game



## Information

For 2 or more players, build the wall together then remove the bricks carefully so that Humpty doesn't fall.

Encourages communication and interaction with social skills (taking turns etc).

Age: 4 years plus

**Contents: 3 orange base pieces, 44 bricks, humpty dumpty and 2 trowels.**

# Dinosaur Puzzle



## Information

This is a lovely hard, peg-board puzzle with a favourite childhood theme. With its simple and colourful shapes and easy to grasp pegs, the puzzle makes an ideal early stages challenge.

Age: 12 months plus

**Contents: Board and 4 pieces.**

## Seasons Puzzle - Set of 4



### Information

Each jigsaw has 12 large, washable, plastic pieces. The picture is also set inside the frame to aid positioning.

Suitable for toddlers, this will help with learning to solve problems (where shall I put this piece?) and also improve motor skills.

To extend play, you can chat about the changing weather in the pictures and the activities and clothing too.

Age: 12 months plus

**Contents: 4 boards with 12 pieces in each.**



# Topsy Turtle



## Information

This encourages interaction with others. You need to listen carefully to Topsy to get him out of the pond. Helps with co-ordination, colour recognition, counting, problem solving.

Age: 3 years plus

**Contents: Turtle with 4 legs, 24 coloured blocks and instructions.**

# Dora Adventure Game



## Information

This board game will help with social interaction, concentration, matching and memory skills. Also colour recognition, counting and an introduction to another language.

Age: 3 years plus

**Contents: Board, instructions, 4 players and stands, 6 puzzle cards and 12 backpack cards.**



# Disney Puzzle, Set of 3



## Information

Enjoy problem solving and building the princess pictures with your child. Can help with hand/eye coordination, these puzzles also aid fine motor skills.

For extended play talk about the colours and the stories behind the pictures.

Age: 4 years plus

**Contents: 3 Princess puzzles, one has 25 pieces, one has 36 pieces and one has 49 pieces.**

## Dora Puzzle, Set of 2



### Information

A puzzle is great for your child's development and sense of achievement.

Age: 4 years plus

**Contents: 2 puzzles, each with 35 pieces.**



# Dora Puzzle, Set of 4



## Information

Puzzles are great for your child's problem solving skills and sense of achievement.

You can also expand their vocabulary by talking about the pictures; What can you see? Where are they going? ....

Age: 3 years plus

**Contents:** There are four jigsaws, with different numbers of pieces, (12,16, 20 and 24).



# 12 piece Tuzzle Puzzle



## Information

A starter peg board with clear white pegs for easy grip and simple shapes to slot easily into place. At the same time your child can expand his/her vocabulary and colour Recognition.

Age: 12 months plus

**Contents: Board and 12 inserts.**

# Space Tuzzle Puzzle, set of 4



## Information

Let your budding astronauts piece together their own space scenes. This set of four has robust, chunky pieces to slot together.

For extended play, talk about the stars, the moon and the sun.

Age: Age 3 years plus

**Contents: 30 pieces and 4 boards.**
