## Starting at 9.30am

1. A Team shall consist of Four Players and can be Men, Ladies or Mixed. If a Parish can only field 3 Players the Lead will play 3 Bowls, the Number Two will play 3 Bowls and the Skip will play 2 Bowls – but they will forfeit 25% of their score in each game.

Minimum age 11 years.

Each Parish may only enter one Team.

Substitutes will only be allowed in exceptional circumstances.

- 2. All Players *must <u>reside</u>* in the Parish or Ward they are representing. This is because it is an Inter-Parish Competition. Where a Player resides between more than one Wychavon Parish or Ward, they may only play for the Parish or Ward in which they predominantly reside. Appearing on the electoral roll for a Parish does not in itself constitute residency. If it is found that a Player does *not* reside in the Parish or Ward they are representing, all points gained by the team in that event will be forfeited.
- 3. Each Captain shall bring with him/her a list of all team members. This must include the full postal address of each team member and must be handed to the Organiser before the competition starts.
- 4. The event shall be conducted under Bowls England rules and regulations (with the exception of rule 1 above).
- 5. Casual dress allowed. Flat rubber soled footwear is mandatory.

- 6. The format for the event will depend on the number of entries. Refreshments and a licensed bar will be available, and a raffle may be held.
- 7. Parish Captains MUST let Sue Collins (contact details below) know by Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September that they will be attending. Any Parish that has not informed Sue by this date will deem to have withdrawn from the event.
- 8. If a Parish or Ward has confirmed to Sue Collins that they will take part, but then does not take part, the Parish or Ward will be deducted 2 points.
- 9. Please note that there is limited parking at the Bowling Club.
- 10. Any protest must be submitted by the Team Captain to the Secretary Sue Collins within SEVEN days of the match in dispute contact details below.
