- 1. Each Team shall consist of Five male Players.
- 2. All Players *must* <u>reside</u> in the Parish or Ward they are representing. This is because it is an Inter-Parish Competition. Where a Player resides between more than one Wychavon Parish or Ward, they may only play for the Parish or Ward in which they predominantly reside. Appearing on the electoral roll for a Parish does not in itself constitute residency. If it is found that a Player does *not* reside in the Parish or Ward they are representing, all points gained by the team in that event will be forfeited.
- 3. Each Captain shall provide two copies of the names and addresses of their team members; this must include the full postal address of each team member. One of these should be retained by the Home Captain for the duration of this year's Games, and the other should be retained by the Away Captain for the duration of this year's Games. Matches must not start until both Team Captains have completed their lists.
- 4. If a Parish or Ward has entered but does not then take part, the Parish or Ward will be deducted 2 points unless the Parish Captain or Parish Organiser has given the event organiser a minimum of 48 hours' notice of non-participation.
- 5. All Games to commence at **8.00pm**.
- 6. All Games will be Straight Start, Double Finish. Away side to the Bull every game.
- 7. For the first rounds, games will be five single games, best of 3 x 501.
- 8. For the quarter-finals, semi-finals and final, two Doubles matches will also be played. These will be played BEFORE the singles, and different players may play the Doubles if a Parish wishes.
- 9. The bust rule shall apply, ie if a player scores more than the number required, then that score shall not count, and the player shall revert back to the score he required prior to the opponent's last throw.

- 10. The 50 Bull shall count as double 25 for the purpose of finishing a Game.
- 11. All matches to be played on a Home or Away basis. After the initial rounds, the Organiser will, wherever possible, ensure that a team, which played away in a previous round, plays at home in a subsequent round. In a case where both winning teams played at home or away, the Organiser will have the final decision.
- 12. The Team that is drawn at Home is responsible for the Venue and Date of each Match to be played. They will contact the Away Team and fix the evening by giving THREE possible dates. THESE MUST NOT BE ON THE SAME DAY OF THE WEEK AND SHOULD PREFERABLY NOT BE IN THE SAME WEEK.
- 13. After the first round, failure to comply with Rule 12 above within 10 days of the date by which the Match is due to be played will concede home advantage to the Away Team. The Away Captain will then arrange for the Match to be played by the due date.
- 14. All matches must be played by the date shown on the draw sheet.
- 15. The date of the Final will be arranged by the Event Organiser in conjunction with the two Captains and will take place on a mutually convenient date at a neutral venue.
- 16. Result to be phoned to the Organiser

BY THE WINNING TEAM NO LATER THAN 48 HOURS AFTER THE MATCH.
