Over the last few months quite a number of things have happened. Firstly we would like to thank all those who contributed to the Parish Hall Community Survey at the beginning of the year. The information offered was very helpful and guided the Committee on deciding on the priorities for improvements to the Hall. As a result of this information an Improvement Business Plan has been developed and already improvements and development are taking place.

Many people will already know the Hall now has 80 new folding chairs and comments from Hall users have been positive. One of the key priorities for the community was the use of the kitchen. We are pleased to inform you that the work necessary to upgrade the status of the kitchen has been completed and thanks to a grant from North Devon Council, local fund raising and community voluntary help the improvements should be in place in readiness for Worlington's Queen's Diamond Jubilee Big Breakfast.

The main priority for the community was to improve the heating in the Hall and a project is under way to find a solution. This is a complex issue as the plan has to include improved heating, a reduction in dampness and condensation in the building and an increase in insulation. We are also looking forward to the Hall playing a role in key events in the coming months, including the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Celebrations and the annual Church Fete.
