Parish Hall Improve and Conserve Project

This Spring edition of the Parish Hall Newsletter is dedicated to our Improve and Conserve Project.

On Friday 15th March 58 people attended a community event at the Parish Hall to learn more about the improvement and conservation plans and to contribute ideas and thoughts that help the project be developed as a community project. There are two elements to the project. 1. improving the internal conditions associated with heating and dampness to enable it to be used more by the community; and 2. conserving the building and maximising its heritage potential as a converted tithe barn dating back to C17th.

The Parish Hall is an important element in our community as it is the only building that offers us the facilities to meet and hold events. Our ambition is that it further develops as a Community Hub, offering a venue for a wider range of social, recreational, cultural, learning, and health-related activities and meetings of groups and organisations.

As a converted tithe barn it is steeped in history and along with other buildings in East Worlington is part of our cultural heritage. The Parish Hall therefore has significant potential to be maintained and conserved to ensure that we and generations to come know about our past, including our culture and lives of people.

We aim to focus on both aspects to secure resources necessary to improve and conserve our Parish Hall. Our plan is a five year plan and we will do what we can when funding becomes available.
