Parish Hall Update

The main priority for the Parish Hall Committee in the last few months has been to make grant applications to secure sufficient funds to make the necessary improvements and conserve the building.

Big Lottery – Reaching Communities Grant

A grant application has been made to the Big Lottery and as of June 2013 we await the outcomes of their decision. The grant focuses on the significant role the Parish Hall has in support our community as the only main venue for community activities and events. Our ambition is to be a 'Community Hub'.

Heritage Lottery

One of the grants we can apply for is the Heritage Lottery. This grant provides support for heritage projects. The Parish Hall is a significant artefact of our heritage and is in a good position to meet the criteria for a grant. The Worlington Heritage Project we are planning is designed to be a community-based project with the Parish Hall as the Heritage Hub. A small group of community members have started to create a Heritage Group to coordinate this project and future details will be available in the next few months.

Community Council of Devon

This grant is designed to support community facilities and therefore East Worlington is in a good position to make an application. The requirements of this grant is that they will fund one third of the cost of the project up to £20,000 and therefore we need to secure the other two thirds. Our own funds make up one third so we only need to find a funding source or benefactor to secure the final third to make an application. The application round closed on 31st July.

Parish Hall Pantomime – Oh no it isn't! Oh yes it is!

The Parish Hall is planning to host a pantomime as a community activity, with proceeds in support of the Parish Hall Thatching Appeal. It is hoped the pantomime will be held early in 2014. A small group have started planning the event.
