This Week's Focus

Progress is made with the thatching of the rear side of the roof. Internally the installation of supporting timbers is completed, and work is started on lining the roof ready for plastering.

Thatcher starts to lay the top layer of thatch

This week the thatcher has started laying the top layer of thatch. Starting on the right hand side of the roof he is working to the left and building layer on layer up the roof.







Joiner completes work on supporting A-frames

The A-frames are supported across the span of the Hall by additional cross-members. These have been installed by the project joiner. New timber has only being installed where necessary and existing timber have been retained and show the character and history of the building.











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Thatching spars

There was concern that the thatching spars might protrude into the roof space and maybe puncture through the plasterboard. Currently this has not being a problem. It is possible just to see in the photographs a spar protruding below the thatch but it does not reach the plasterboard line.



Lining the roof

The roof is being lined by plasterboard. This is required on this project to provide a fire check and for economic reasons.

Between the thatch and plasterboard is a layer of insulation.

The work of installing the plasterboard is precise and each piece has to be cut to fit round the shapes of the timbers.








The stage
