

Editorial Team Volunteer

InterAct is the only inter-faith, cultural and lifestyle magazine produced by and for students in the UK.

Since 2006 students and graduates from all over London have come together as a multifaith Editorial Team of volunteers to produce a quarterly issue of the magazine. It's a great opportunity for students to gain experience in print journalism, design or photography. InterAct is distributed online (via www.interact-uk.org.uk) and in print (distributed free to students at universities across London).

InterAct aims to deliver a platform for dialogue between students from different faiths and increase awareness and understanding about different religions and beliefs, while providing students with the means to express their views and opinions on current affairs, religion, arts, philosophy and society.

The Editorial Team is responsible for the project and how it will develop. Throughout the programme the team will have access to professionals working in print media, graphic design and photography. In addition to this, workshops will be delivered by media professionals covering the following topics:

- Project planning and team working
- Print media industry
- Writing with impact
- Design & Layout

Requirement

• Initiative, commitment and enthusiasm for the project are the most important requirements!

- Living in London, for the duration of the project*
- Attend weekly meetings (dates to be confirmed).

• Ability to work well in a team. Although everybody is going to be assigned specific tasks, it is still a team project, so you might have to step in to help somebody that may be struggling with theirs.

• Able to commit for 3 months (between Oct-Dec 2011), and able to volunteer between 2-5 hours a week.

*If you will be away from London during these months (September - November) but available to volunteer remotely (via email and phone) please still apply; although priority will be given to those living in London for the duration of the project.

Role Vacancies

We are looking for volunteers to fill the following positions and create the Autumn issue of InterAct magazine as a team:

• Editor:

As you might expect the Editor is responsible for all things editorial. Working closely with the Creative Director, Sub-Editor and Researchers you will manage the written content of the magazine, planning layout (with the Creative Director) and ensuring it is submitted on time to designers and updating the Project Coordinator regularly.

Writer/Section-Editors

Responsible for the editing of articles, they will also have a say in the deciding and writing of the content for the magazine and support the Editor as needed.

Creative Editor

Responsible for leading the Visual team and working closely with the Editor you will coordinate the design and layout of the magazine.

Graphic Designers

Listening to the ideas of the rest of the team you will be responsible (with all graphic designers) for creating each page/spread of the magazine. Support Creative Director.

Photographer/illustrators

Attend interviews and team meetings, to take photographs of the project, editorial team, items or people for articles. Provide fitting images to include with writers and contributors. Drawings and illustrations are also welcome!
