FPS Conservation Session

We meet with the City Council Ranger at 10.00am in the car park on Cooks Wood Road. We work on a variety of tasks, for example maintaining our Lowland Heathland, developing wildflower meadows, making sure paths are unobstructed and the area is clean and tidy. We have a break for a drink and a chat at about 11.15am and finish by 12.30pm. All tools are provided by the Ranger, who gives training in the use of equipment. Wear sturdy shoes, warm clothes in winter, and **come and join us**.

Forest Garden

Tim Shortland from the City Council Forestry team leads the Forest Garden sessions. The Forest Garden is a productive managed woodland, which produces food for both people and wildlife. It is designed to need a small amount of input; some weeding, and a bit of mulching and pruning. No digging is used, except for removing weeds. We are looking forward to harvesting blackcurrants, gooseberries, raspberries, plums, apples, blackberries, kiwi fruit, and strawberries. We meet in the car park on Cooks Wood Road at 10.45am and walk over to the garden for 11.00am. We have a break at 1.00pm, you can bring your own drink and snack or food to share. We usually make a hot drink too. We finish at around 2.00pm. All tools and appropriate training are provided. Wear sturdy shoes, warm clothes in winter, and **come and join us**. The garden is a beautiful tranquil place, where all are welcome.

Art events

Come and join us for a drawing/painting session as we begin to make a collection of art work representing Parkwood Springs. No experience needed, just a willingness to have some fun trying anything from bark rubbing to watercolour painting. You can bring any materials that you have at home - paper, pens, pencils, crayons etc. or we can provide things if you need them. Bring a garden chair if you would like. All ages from 2 to 92 (or older!) welcome, children will need to be accompanied by an adult. The art events follow a morning activity on Parkwood Springs, so if you want to come to both, bring a picnic and make a day of it! We will meet near the sculpture in the Cooks Wood Road car park, which is where the morning activities will finish.
