## RULES

1. For riders 16 years and over and covered by third party insurance through private, BHS, Pony Club or equine club insurance.
  2. All horses/ponies in ridden classes must be at least 4 years of age and 5 years of age in classes **3 & 24**.
  3. **The Judge's decision is final.** Any complaints to be made in writing to the secretary within 1 hour of the occurrence of the event giving rise to the complaint, with a £20 deposit which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
  4. Neither the organisers of this event, nor any person acting on their behalf, the owners of the show ground or agents acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident injury or illness to animals, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
  5. **Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC competition**
    - i) PAS015 (1998 or 2011) and must have official BSI Kite mark ii) VG1 01.040 (2014-12) and must have official BSI Kite mark iii) ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) and must have official SEI Mark iv) SNELL E2001 and must have official SNELL label and number v) AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) and must have official SAI global mark**It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may invalidate any insurance. A back protector is recommended for jumping classes.**
  6. Each horse may enter a maximum of **5** classes. A maximum of 3 of which may be showjumping or working hunter classes. Please plan your entries to avoid clashes; however should your classes clash on the day we will not hold back other classes in your absence other than with the express prior consent of the judge and at our discretion. We regret any inconvenience however delaying a class to cater for some entrants unfortunately has a knock on effect for other competitors.
  7. EDRC members will be given points towards the club's Show Challenge trophy, six points for 1st down to one point for 6th in class, with two extra points for each championship and one extra for each reserve championship.
  8. Only EDRC members are eligible for challenge trophies, which will be presented at the members Annual Function. EDRC member's show jumping annual points awarded to members who have pre-entered a minimum of one show jumping class.
  9. **DOGS NOT ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUND.**
  10. We ask that competitors avoid competing in classes where they receive lessons from or own a horse bred, broken or produced by the judge.
  11. Horse/rider combinations in **class 20 may not enter classes 3, 23 & 24.**
  12. Horse/rider combinations in **class 21 may not enter class 24.**
  13. Show jumping classes will be run under British Riding Club Rules.
  14. **No stallions allowed in show classes.**
  15. Rosettes to 6th place in all classes.
  16. This competition gives a donation to an equine charity and **no entry fees will be returned** unless the competition is cancelled, when a secretarial fee may be taken.
  17. The organisers reserve the right to split or combine classes according to entries.
  18. EDRC members helping for at least 3hr (1/2 a day) can earn a voucher towards a free entry at the next EDRC show. Please present to the Secretary confirming that you are claiming your voucher at the end of your day /½ day to have this recorded.
  19. Any combination of horse & rider may enter a class HC and can still compete in other classes competitively (as long as not out of class due to class restrictions).
