Indoor warm-up, all classes ridden on ALL WEATHER SURFACE

Normal competition attire UNLESS wearing fancy dress (with appropriate safety hat - see rule 6
 - and riding boots).

!!PRIZE FOR BEST HALLOWEEN COSTUME (horse and/or rider)!!

Class 1 – Starter Novice (A5) Fences 50cm max –
 horse & rider combination not to have won 3 firsts SJ up to 50cm and/or any one class at 60cm or above.

Class 2 – Nursery Novice (A5) Fences 60cm max –
 horse & rider combination not to have won 3 firsts SJ at 60cm or above.

Class 3 – Novice (A5) Fences 70cm max – horse & rider combination not to have won £50 BS

Class 4 – Accumulator Fences from 60cm to 80cm, joker at 90cm
 Riders will have 45 seconds to get as many points as they can. Each jump will be worth a certain number of points. Each jump will be able to be jumped in both directions and can be jumped a maximum of 3 times. Joker will be worth 200 points, but 200 points will be deducted from final score if it is knocked down. Whistle will go after 45 seconds and rider must go over finish line to stop the clock. If there is equality of points, (nearest to) time will decide the winner. Not open to riders entered in Class 7 (Open).

Class 5 – Intermediate (A7) Fences 80cm max – horse & rider combination not to have won £75 BS

Class 6 – Small Open (A7) Fences 90cm max – horse & rider combination not to have won £100 BS

Class 7 – Open (A7) Fences 100cm (higher in second round if demand)
 Open to any horse & rider combination

****Please note:** A second round may be entered in any class as HC. The score from your first round will count towards jump off/placings**

Horses may be entered in a maximum of 3 classes, including HC and the Accumulator (see rule 2).

Members points will be awarded in all classes, including the Accumulator.

Rosettes to be awarded 1st to 6th for all classes.

Note 1: All competitors must pre-enter at least 1 class by closing date.

Note 2: NON MEMBERS: Additional classes may be entered on the day at £14.00 per class

Note 3: MEMBERS: Additional classes may be entered on the day at £11.00 per class
 (Note 2 and 3 on the basis of Note 1 above)

Rules

1. All horses to be age 4yrs and over and **all riders to be aged 16 years or over.**
2. Horses may not be entered in more than 3 classes (including HC).
3. Horses entered in class 1 or 2 may not enter class 6 or 7.
4. Strictly no dogs.
5. This competition is run under British Riding Club rules 2019.
6. Under BRC rules a hard hat to one of the following standards must be worn: PAS015 (1998 or 2011) provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked, or:
ASTM F1163 (2004a or 4A onwards) provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001 and SNELL E2016, or: AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) provided they are SAI global marked, or:
VG101.040 (2014-12) provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked, and:
The chin strap must have a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified.
7. Neither the organisers of this event, nor any person acting on their behalf, the owners of the showground or agents acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
8. EDRC members will receive league table points in all classes. Memberships must be fully paid up by closing date of entries to qualify for points.
9. The judge's decision is final. Any complaints must be made in writing to the secretary accompanied by £20 and the complaint must be made within one hour of the incident.
10. Entry fees only refunded if the show is cancelled, postponed, or classes are full. An administration fee may be taken from each competitor.
11. Cantering is allowed only in practice and competition areas.
12. There will be a limited number of entries available in each class.
13. PLEASE NOTE, use of this venue is subject to the venue, specifically including the parking area, being left clean & tidy. As a result, ANY ENTRANTS NOT LEAVING THE PARKING AREAS AS THEY FOUND THEM WILL NOT HAVE FUTURE ENTRIES ACCEPTED. PLEASE THEREFORE ENSURE YOU REMOVE ALL HAY/DROPPINGS/LITTER ETC.
14. All horses/ponies must be vaccinated against equine flu in accordance with BRC Rules (primary and secondary vaccinations as a minimum must have been received, along with any annual boosters falling due thereafter). For the avoidance of doubt, 6 monthly boosters are not required.
15. All horses/ponies must be accompanied by their passports. These must be available at the Show for inspection on demand.
16. Any horse/pony not complying with rules 14 and 15 will be required to leave the Showground with immediate effect, along with any accompanying/competing traveling companion (regardless of whether the accompanying horse/pony complies with the flu vaccination rules). No refund of entry fees will apply in respect of any horse/pony affected by this rule.
