Ring 1- Inhand 9am Judge: твс

- Class 1. Condition and Turnout.
- Class 2. **'Show & Know'**. Horse/pony any age, height or type.

This class is open to all although is primarily an opportunity for competitors less experienced in showing who would like the chance to learn in 'real time' within a class, and for competitors who have new or inexperienced horses/ponies they want to show to their best potential and would value a judges input. The class will be judged on quality and trueness to type of the horse/pony presented, but each competitor will then receive a brief review from the judge, including guidance on anything they could do to improve their performance and/or the judges impression of the horse/pony. This could be tips on presentation, handling, ringcraft, turnout, dress etc, which can be taken forward to future in-hand and ridden classes.

- Class 3. **Youngstock.** Horse/pony 4 years old and under any height or type.
- Class 4. **Veteran.** Horse/pony 15 years and over any height or type.
- Class 5. **Coloured.** Horse/pony any age, height or type inc. appaloosa. No whole colours (dun/palomino etc).
- Class 6. **Mountain and Moorland.** Registered and unregistered any age.

Ring Championship- 1st and 2nd places from classes 2-6.

Ring 2- Ridden 10am Judge: Alison Smith

- Class 7. Tack and Turnout.
- Class 8. **Veteran.** Horse/Pony 15 years and over any height or type.
- Class 9. **Novice Ridden.** Horse/pony 4yrs & over. Walk/trot only. TO BE RIDDEN IN A SNAFFLE BIT ONLY. For true Novice horses and/or Riders. Horse/Rider combination not to have won any open ridden class.
- Class 10. **Cobs and Heavy Horses**. Horse/pony 4ys & over. Traditional, show cobs and heavy horse breeds.
- Class 11. **Coloured**. Horse/Pony 4 yrs & over any height or type including appaloosa.
- Class 12. **Mountain and Moorland.** Registered and unregistered 4 years and over.
- Class 13. **Hunter.** Horse 4 yrs & over of hunter type, any height.
- Class 14. **Riding Horse**. Horse 4 yrs & over of riding horse type any height.
- Class 15. **Riding Club Horse/Pony.** Horse/Pony 4 yrs & over any height or type-includes 1 jump approx 2'.

RULES

- 1. All riders must be 16 years and over and covered by third party insurance through private, BHS, Pony Club or equine club insurance.
- 2. All horses/ponies in ridden classes must be at least 4 years of age.
- 3. Class 9, Novice Ridden, may be limited in numbers for reasons of safety.
- 4. The Judge's decision is final. Any complaints to be made in writing to the secretary within 1 hour of the occurrence of the event giving rise to the complaint, with a £20 deposit which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
- 5. Neither the organisers of this event, nor any person acting on their behalf, the owners of the show ground or agents acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident injury or illness to animals, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 6. Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC affiliated competition:-
- i) PAS015 (1998 or 2011) provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked
- ii) VG1 01.040 (2014-12) provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked
- iii) ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) provided they are SEI marked
- iv) SNELL E2001 or SNELL E2016
- v) AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) provided they are SAI global mark
- It is the riders responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may invalidate any insurance.
- 7. Each horse may enter multiple classes (Max 4). Please plan your entries to avoid clashes; however should your classes clash on the day we will not hold back other classes in your absence other than with the express prior consent of the judge and at our discretion. We regret any inconvenience however delaying a class to cater for some entrants unfortunately has a knock on effect for other competitors.
- 8. DOGS NOT ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUND.
- 9. We ask that competitors avoid competing in classes where they receive lessons from, or own a horse bred, broken or produced by, the judge.
- 10. The show is not open to Stallions/Entire horses.
- 11. Rosettes to 6th place in all classes.
- 12. The organisers reserve the right at any time to close entries to any given class if they are over subscribed, or split or combine classes according to entries.
- 13. EDRC members helping for at least 3hr (1/2 day) can earn a voucher for a free entry at an EDRC show. Please present to the Secretary confirming you are claiming your voucher at the end of your day /½ day to have this recorded.
- 14. Cheques to be made payable to Edinburgh & District Riding Club.
