

CHRISTOPHER PLUMB

**Private, 1st/3rd (City of London) Battalion,
London Regiment (Royal Fusiliers),
167th Brigade, 56th (1st London) Division.**

Christopher Plumb was born in Ettington in 1881. He was the last child of John Plumb and his wife Ann, nee Cusack, who moved to the village in the early 1870s. After leaving school he found work as a gardener and by 1901 he had moved away to work in Maidenhead, Berkshire. Later he went to Balham, London and was married there in 1907 to Rose Emma Quantrell. They had two sons and two daughters born from 1908 to 1916.

He was killed in action in France on Thursday 10th May 1917. He is commemorated on the Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais.
