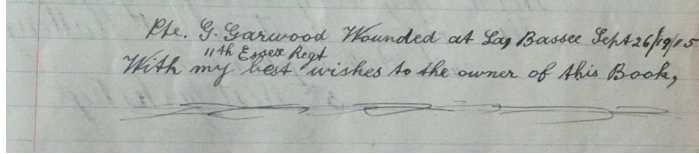


Private G Garwood 11th Essex Regiment



Private Garwood left the above entry in the Ledger.

It has not been possible to find out anything about what he did before and after the war. However the Medal Record Index and the Medal and Award Roll showed he attained the rank of corporal and survived the war. After his stay in hospital he returned to the Western Front His army number was 23909. He was awarded the Military Medal which is recorded in the London Gazette on the 17 July 1917.

He was attached to a Trench Mortar Battery. No detail has been discovered as to his actions which lead to him being awarded the Military Medal
