

Using Camera and Photo Apps

Take a photo on an ipad.

1. To prepare your shot, do any of the following:

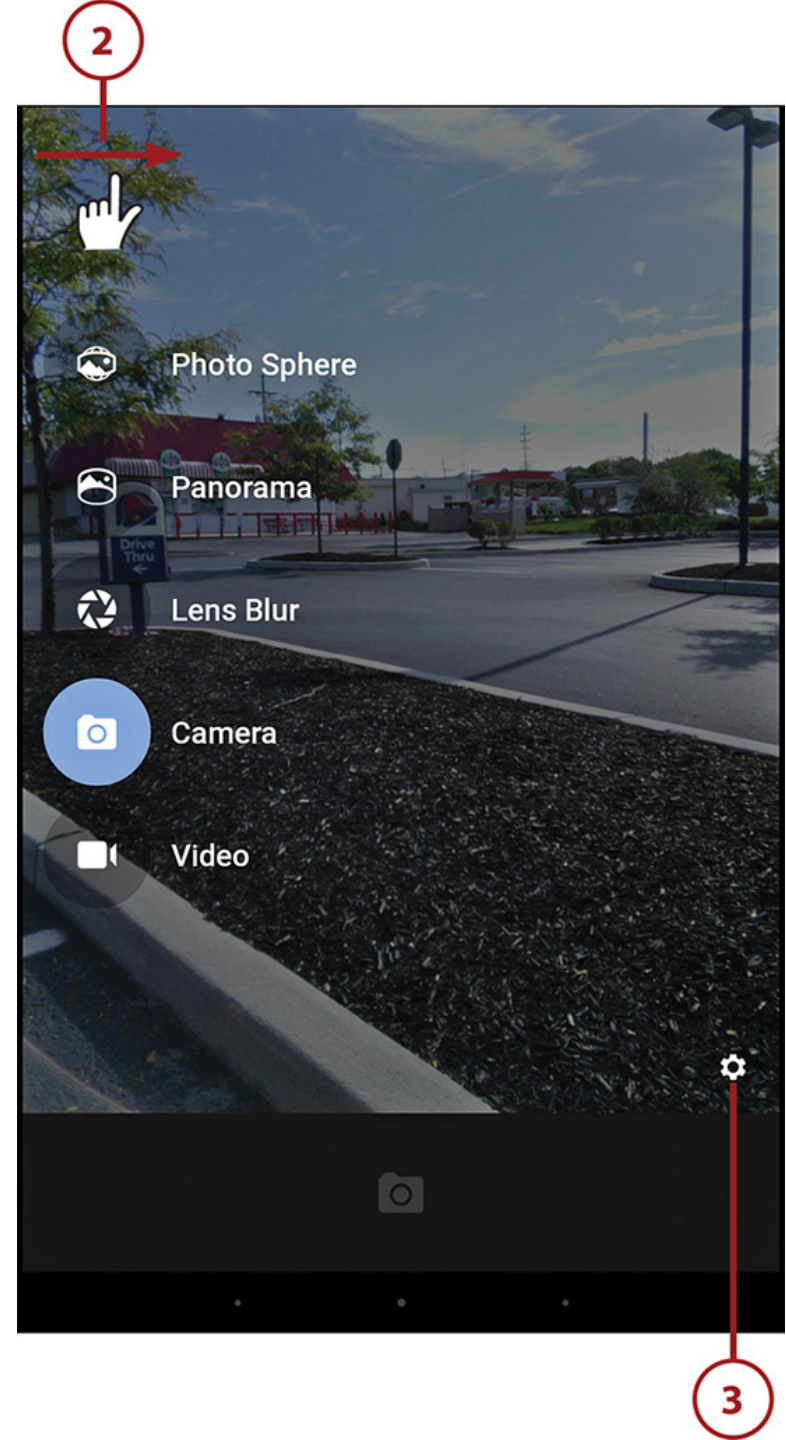
- **Zoom in and out:** Pinch the screen or drag the slider on the left-side of the screen.
- **Choose a photo mode:** Slide the mode selector to choose Video, Photo, Square, or Pano.
- **Take a selfie:** Tap to switch to the rear-facing camera.
- **Use the timer:** Stabilize your iPad and frame your shot. Tap , then tap 3s or 10s.

2. Tap the Shutter button or press either volume button to take the photo.

Note no flash on later ipads!

Taking a photo on Android

- 1 Tap to launch the Camera.
- 2 Swipe in from the left of the screen to change the camera mode between still camera, panoramic camera, Lens Blur, Photo Sphere, and video camera.
- 3 Tap to change the camera settings.

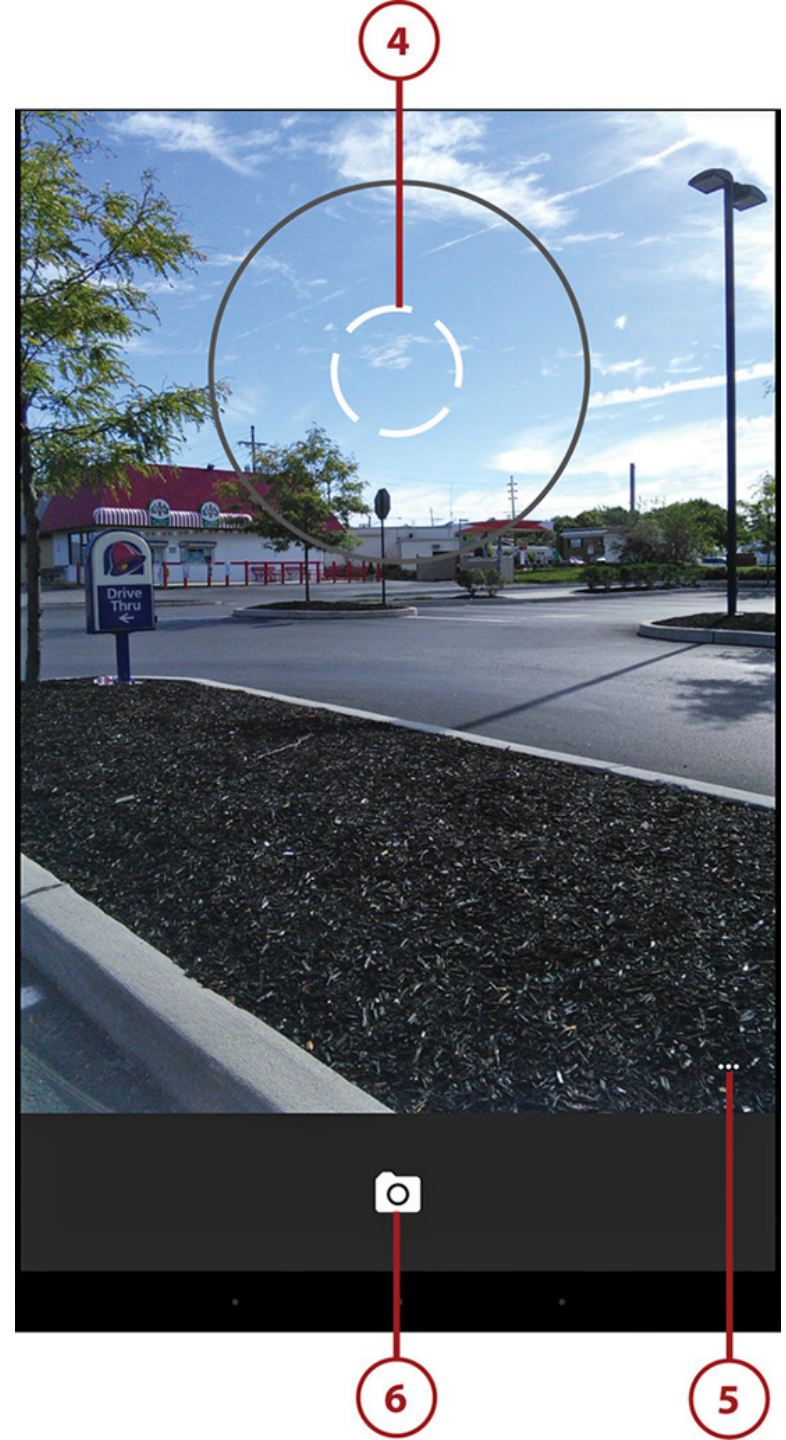


4 Tap anywhere in the frame to focus specifically in the area.

5 Tap to switch between the front-facing and rear-facing cameras, overlay a grid pattern on the screen, or manually adjust the exposure setting.

6 Tap to take a picture.

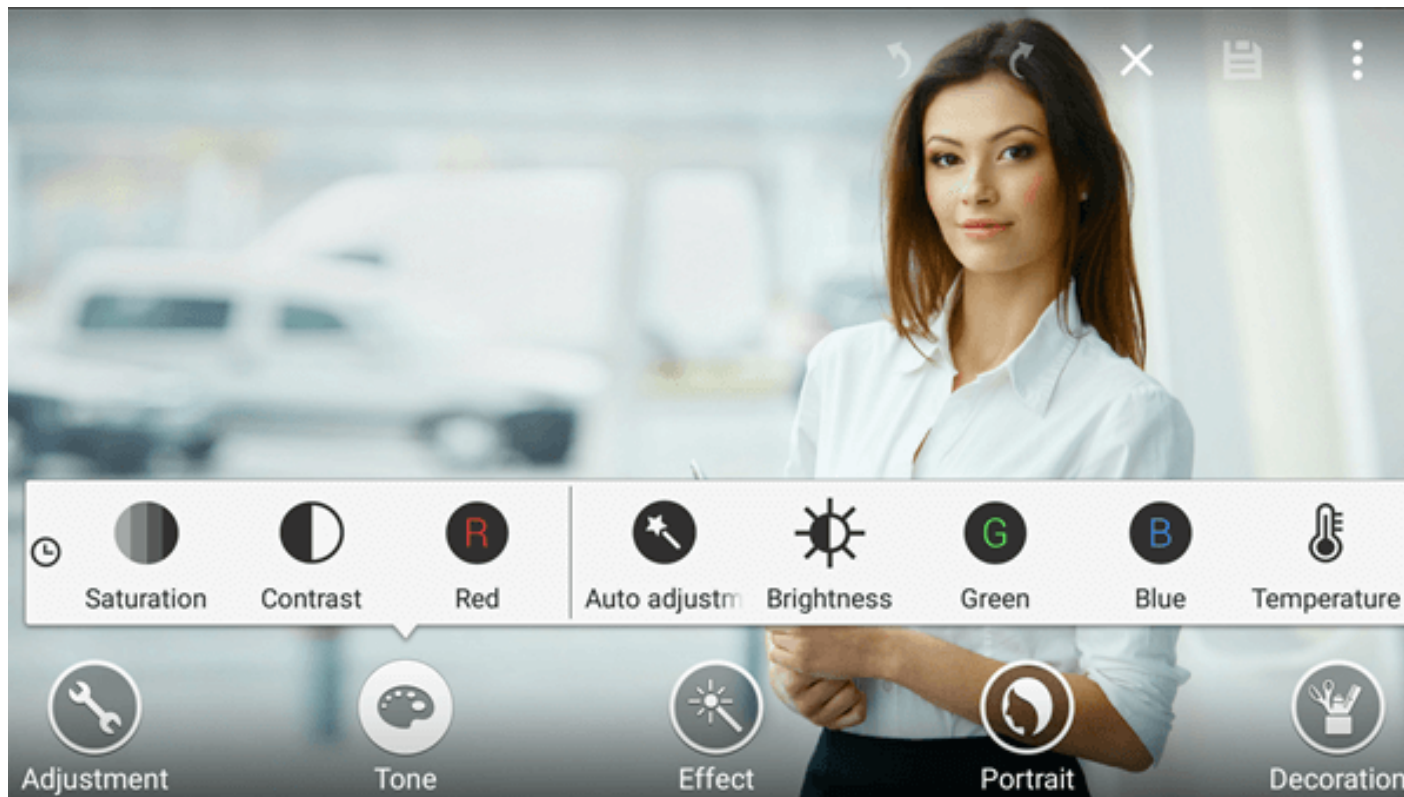


Editing a photo on Ipad



Editing photos in the Gallery App on Android

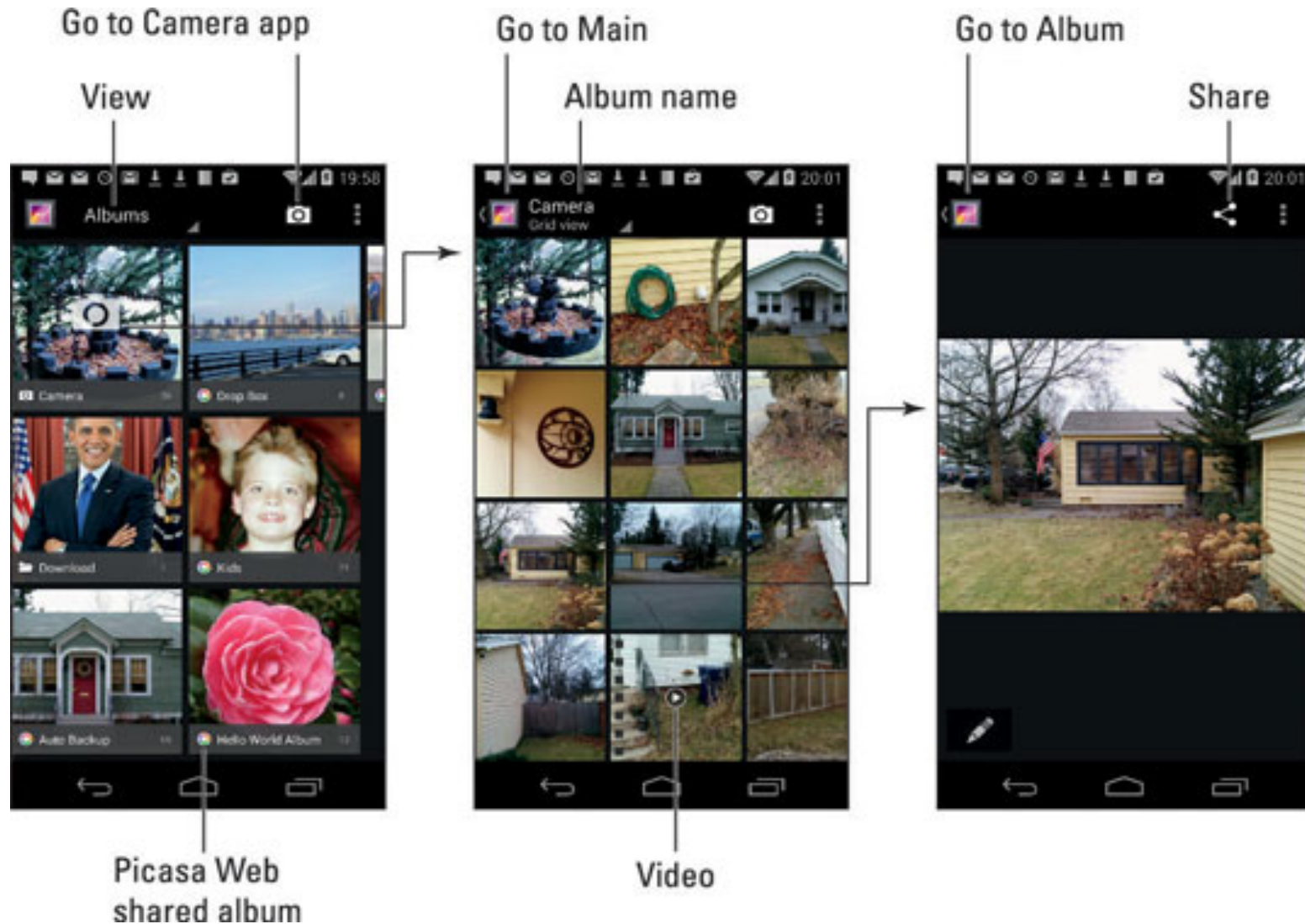
- select a photo from the gallery. Then tap the Edit button/icon.
- Choose the "Adjustment" command. You can edit the picture by rotating, cropping, and resizing it.
- You can make other changes to the photo

Using Photos on your ipad

1. Enter your photos app and click on “Photos” from menu at bottom of screen.
2. Click back marker at top of screen on left – keep clicking to see where you go
3. Click on a photo – click the heart and it is saved to “favorite” album
4. Click on “For you” at bottom of screen and explore –
5. Click on “Albums” – explore go down the screen
6. Select some photos from Photo page and save to a folder – try “sideshow”

Android users: The following figure shows a typical Gallery app with images organized into albums, or piles.

- Touch an album in the Gallery app to display that album's contents; the pictures appear in a grid of thumbnail previews (middle). Swipe the screen left and right to peruse them all.
- Touch an individual thumbnail in the album to view that item full size on the screen, as shown on the right. You can rotate the phone horizontally (or vertically) to see the image in another orientation.
- Videos stored in an album appear with a Play icon on the screen. Touch that icon to play the video. As the video is playing, touch the screen again to see the controls to pause the video.
- You back up from an image or a video to an album by touching the Back icon or the app icon in the upper-left corner of the screen.
