

JOSEPH MOLE

Joseph Mole was born on the 6th March 1883 in Stoneleigh, Warwickshire, another son of Henry & Isabella Mole, and Henry was employed as a shepherd.

By 1891 the family had moved to Combroke.

In 1901 Joseph was a seaman serving on the “St George” in the Royal Navy, No 204019.

According to a sheet of his service record which has survived, he was a gardener before he enlisted at Portsmouth, and that his character was very good.

The ships he served on were :-

Impregnable
Black Prince
Minataur
Agincourt
St. George

He didn't get to serve in the war, as he died from extreme fever on 3rd October 1902 whilst serving overseas.
