

EDWARD CHARLES MOUNTFORD

Edward was born in 1885 in Warwick the eldest son of Joseph & Mary Ann Mountford. Before the war he was employed as a gardener.

In 1891 the family were living at Park Farm, Fullbrooke, where Joseph was employed as a waggoner, but by 1901 they had moved to Charlecote.

He enlisted into the Army Service Corps No. T 3/025435, in Birmingham on 28th October 1914. In his Pension Record for the WW1 on his enlistment, he was 26 years & 124 days old, was 5ft and 4 ½ inches tall and weighed 119 lbs. He also had a wart on his back. and was employed as a carrier.

He stayed in this country from the day of his enlistment until the 16th January 1915 when he became non-effective, and therefore discharged due to multiple painful? Therefore he didn't have a medal entitlement.

He is mentioned in the Charlecote school Roll of Honour
