## Carers Personal Concerns and Care Funding

Elizabeth Webbe will additionally be covering all aspects of Care Funding, specifically funding which is available from the DSS, the Non-means Tested Funding from the PCT, the private funding which might be available, the insurance products which might be used to pay for care and, in particular, financial advice concerning how to maximise the use of assets currently owned to make them last as long as possible.
