Minutes from committee meeting Tuesday 22nd Aug 2017

- 1) Minutes from last committee meeting on the 18th July 2017 approved.
- 2) Membership & Treasures report (AU).
 - 114 members of DCC all time high!
 - £6,700 in bank
 - Cumberland account at last allowing AU to take out monies but one final form still outstanding to be signed by BM & DN.
- 3) Club kit update (HA).
 - Thanks to HA for her endeavours and patience in processing orders.
 - Kit order now closed and will be sent off to Kalas on Friday, HA dealt with a few late orders as expected.
 - £1,300 of orders, slightly up on the previous.
 - Wide range of kit ordered
 - Hoodies CS to investigate
- 4) Events: a) TT Loch Ken review (CS).
 - Thanks to CS for all his hard work to ensure the event went well, all riders round safe and all received an accurate time.
 - Some excellent feedback.
 - All bodes well for this becoming an annual event, however some lessons have been learned for the future to fine tune and become even better.
 - More volunteers needed for next year and designated marshalling and Race HQ teams.
 - Agreed £100 donation to Stewartry rugby club for the use of their excellent facilities for the Race HQ.
 - Expenses to be reimbursed to CS and Beatrice Acklam. Chief timekeeper Gordon Johnston donated his expenses back to DCC.
 - Awaiting confirmation of payment made to DCC from CTT.

b) TT league, race to the hills and race calendar (CS)

- Lockerbie TT cancelled on safety grounds last week rain and high winds.
- DCC 10TT league will be decided tomorrow at Glencaple.
- Final DG TT League event on Wed 30th August, 13TT at Brownhall prizes to be awarded at the DCC end of season Celebration/Prize giving event.
- Race to the hills runs (4) on Wed evenings in TT gaps was a great success.
- Invitation from Classic Racing to join them on their unofficial Tuesday evening training runs round Caerlaverock received and noted.
- 5) Review of programmed rides (BM et al).
 - a) Short beginner's rides.
 - Successful in bringing in a small number of new riders hopefully to be taken under the wing of group 4 (social group) on Saturdays going forward. Murray McPherson to lead the last official intro ride on Sat 3/9.
 - Hopefully CS will be able to offer more coaching courses in the autumn for new/improving riders.
 - b) Saturday rides, 4 groups default
 - GC has put the 4 group model up on the Website with the new mph for the groups. Hopefully will work going forward, to be monitored & reviewed.
 - c) Sunday rides.
 - Not much feedback but certainly more popular if weather poor on the Saturday. Worth continuing to offer this option.
 - d) DCC Ladies rides.
 - Very successful so far although not many progressing to the Saturday runs yet.
 - Many have now joined DCC.
 - Alison, Gill and Jackie now organising meets and routes.
 - e) Solway Sportive (BM)
 - Successful event good feedback from riders.
 - Numbers down on 2016, late publicity?
 - Date confirmed for 10th anniversary event Sunday 20th May 2018.
 - Proceeds split 40% Devorgilla Rotary charities/40% Dalbeattie initiative charities and 20% to DCC which was £388.06 cheque given to AU.
 - Slentries electronic timing very successful and worth extra costs.
 - Route over Carruchan beeches road avoiding Toll bar and Pleasance avenue junctions worked well and kept for 2018.
 - Same 3 runs and entry fees for 2018 (£10 short, £25 medium & £30 long).
 - Although Rotary providing bulk of marshals on the day still need some DCC members with cycling knowledge to help with start/finish and signs.

- f) Track session
 - AU to liaise with Gordon McNeil to look at possibilities of a track session for DCC club members (preferably not a Sunday evening)
- 6) Welfare right officer to be discussed at the AGM.
- 7) Winter events: pilates, turbo etc (GC/BM).

Thought best to keep the DGtri club turbo/core session separate and ask DCC member Clive (a pilates instructor) to put on a specific pilates session for DCC members through the winter.

- 8) End of summer social event (all)
 - DN has offered very kindly offered to host a post Saturday morning run BBQ/social event at his place.
 - End of September, possibly Saturday the 30th a possible date if convenient with Dave.
- 9) End of season event to celebrate achievements and prize giving (all).
 - To be held at the end of October/beginning November, after school hols preferred so Sat 4th November looks favourite.
 - An afternoon event with simple refreshments to celebrate the achievements of the DCC riders throughout the season and present prizes.
 - Possibly take donations for the catering so that DCC funds can be spent more on cycling matters.
 - DN has identified some possible venues, BM to look into any other possibilities before liaising via email to make a decision asap.
