Devil on Wheels TT Course

Course Details

In 1839 the world changed. Kirkpatrick Macmillan had invented the first pedal bicycle. Life would never be the same again. The Devil on Wheels TT is a homage to the great Dumfriesshire Blacksmith and Inventor. The 18 mile course circles the birth-place of KM at Keir just south of Thornhill. Some of the roads will undoubtedly have been ridden on during Macmillans first test outings on his new Velocipede.

Starting in the Village of Penpont the parcours heads west towards Kirkland hit its first climb of Cloan Hill after 2 miles. After the descent, there is a sharp left turn onto the Dunscore road. Riders should take care at this junction as speeds will be high. The road undulates with a short climb upto dunscore with a further left turn towards Auldirth. From here the road is fast for 2 miles keep left and then left again onto the last climb and 5 miles section towards Keir and the finish.

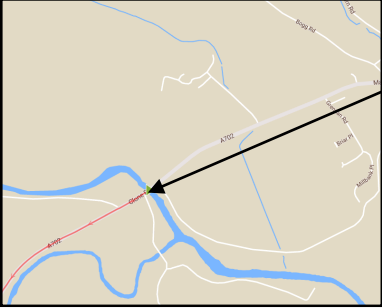
Total elevation for the course is approx. 918ft



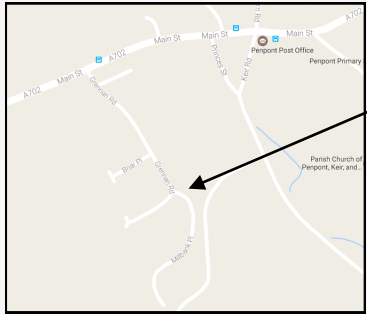
Start line is just outside Penpont

Parking is less than 1/2km away in the town.

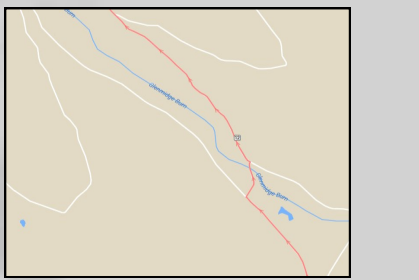
Start Line
