Event Results

Walkers Cycling Club hosted the Scottish Cyclocross Championships at Irvine Beach on the 6th December. There were some great performances from South West riders with Janet Erskine (Ayr Roads CC) winning the vet 40 women's race and Catherine Logan (Walkers CC) 3rd in vet 50 women. It was a South West 1-2 in the vet 60s with Alex McAllister (Ayr Roads CC) taking the win with John Walker (Walkers CC) in 2^{nd.} Course designer, Neil Walker (Walkers CC) came 5th in the senior men's race.
