Child Protection

Following recent media attention around child protection in sport, Scottish Cycling has received the following safeguarding update for SGB staff from our partners at Safeguarding in Sport:

"In light of recent media attention we have had some enquiries from SGBs in relation to how they should respond to historic allegations. For clarification:

• If somebody raises child protection concerns in relation to a coach / volunteer who is currently practicing then you should follow your 'Responding to Concerns' procedure. (For Scottish Cycling this can be found <u>here</u>)

• If it is a historical allegation then you should follow the same procedure, record the information and signpost the individual to Police Scotland on '101'

• If you have a concern about a child's immediate safety then this should be passed on to Police or Social Work
