Code of Conduct

This code of conduct is to ensure that everyone has a good time over camp. You will be representing both your Unit and District while away and whilst we don't expect you to be angels there are some basic rules that apply to ALL Explorer Scouts from Wizards Explorer Unit. The Scout Law embodies this Code of Conduct as follows:

The Scout Law

A Scout is to trusted

A Scout is loyal

A Scout is Friendly and Considerate

A Scout belongs to the world wide family of Scouts

A Scout has courage in all difficulties

A Scout makes good use of time and is careful of possessions and property

A Scout has self-respect and respect for others

You are representing 8th Deal Wingham Scout Group and your Leaders. You should act responsibly and with courtesy at all times. Please be courteous to other people at all times and act responsibly. Be helpful and considerate at all times.

8th Deal Leaders are acting in loco parentis and they will be the final and undisputed arbiters in all matters.

You must be punctual at all times. Lateness will inconvenience the whole group.

You must obey instructions from all Leaders, campsite staff and instructors at all times. They are usually made for your own safety.

You must have respect for other people and other people's property. Bullying in any form (racist, verbal, physical) will not be tolerated. Disrespectful behaviour and foul language will also not be tolerated.

You should be dressed suitably – following guidelines from the Leaders in charge.

You may not leave the group camping area unless:

You are given permission to by your Leaders

You are in a group with at least 3 others

You return by the time you agreed with your Leaders

You are responsible for the security of your own possessions. Do not take valuables – this includes phones, iPods, electronic games, tablets etc. Any items found will be confiscated until the end of camp.

You must follow the specific instructions of your Leaders at all times.

Once tent allocations have been made, no alterations will be made. You are not to enter any tent other than the tent you have been allocated or the mess and communal tents. No one is to leave their tent at night except to visit the toilet.

You can only go to toilet in the toilet block. If you are caught by campsite staff using any other part of the campsite you will be asked to leave the campsite.

Quiet time is 11pm to 7pm – quiet time means quiet!

You will keep to the camp rules at all times.

I agree to abide by the guidelines in this Code of Conduct and understand that failure to do so will be taken very seriously by the 8th Deal Scout Group. This may result in being sent home or forfeiting the right to participate in future trips or visits.
