AN outstanding exhibition of the works of Alton Art Society is now on display at the Allen Gallery, Church Street, Alton, and the 69 exhibits in oils and watercolours have been produced by the talented members of the Society in a manner which will easily appeal to the most inexperienced laymen.

The entries, all of which are for sale, cover foreign scenes and English, Welsh and Irish counties by local and other artists; and also animals and birds, gardens and snow scenes.

Local watercolours include Curtis Museum, Alton, by Patricia Lesley Smith; Autumn, Kingsley Pond, H. Taylor; Castle Street, Farnham; Fiona Mearns; Holybourne, by F. R. Raymond Capey; Anstey Mill, L. H. P. Wilding; The Butts, Alton, L. H. P. Wilding; Snow at Wield, Dorothy Dean; the Zig-Zag, Selborne, by Hilda Frank.
