## **NICK POLLARD'S RESEARCH PROJECT**

## 2009 LONDON MINIFEST

This event will take place on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> November at Faraday house, Old Gloucester Street, Holborn, London.

It will be a full day of writing, publishing and performance related workshops, celebratory readings and networking with community writing and publishing groups from all over the UK. The attendance fee is £15 per head (£10 Concessions) including a buffet lunch and refreshments.

GROW is hiring a 49 Seater coach to take us there and back. Seats on the coach for MiniFest attendees cost £8 each. Seats must be paid for in advance.

The Coach will leave Roosevelt Court, Stonehouse Drive at 7am arriving at Faraday House, Holborn at 9.30am.

It will leave Faraday House at 6.30pm returning to Roosevelt Court at 9pm.
