DIDDY LEAGUE ROUND 3

Redditch hosted the final round of the Nuneaton & District Diddy League on 26th June at Worcester. Only promoted this year to Division 1, we faced a against monumental task Halesowen, placed 2nd in the league after 2 rounds. All the swimmers were fired up and not to be outdone, a vocal group of RSC spectators took the roof off. The whole team raised their game and Redditch took an early lead with some truly brilliant swims.

DIDDY LEAGUE ROUND 3 continued

Our very young swimmers shone with Daniel Noke and Tyler Hartles having to 'swim up' a year as 10 year olds with Will Moss and Adam Beaumont in the Medley relay, the boys achieved a stunning 1st place. In the equivalent age group freestyle relay, Tyler and Tom Page swam up a year with Adam and Will, finishing in an impressive 3rd place. Our 9 and 10 year old girls, took double victories in the freestyle and medley relays; Laura Coward, Rosie Potter, Sally Monk, Rebecca Winn (9 years) and Megan Moss, Madeleine Hargreaves, Laura Cowley and Poppy McGourlay (10 years). In total we took 5 individual 1st places - Daniel Noke (9 yr) 25m back, Rebecca Winn (9 yr) 25m breaststroke, Poppy McGourlay (10 yr) 25m fly, Oliver Thomson (11 yr) 50m back and Jake Rowland (12 yr) 50m fly, 6 relay 1st places - Sally Monk, Laura Coward, Rosie Potter and Rebecca Winn (9 yrs) medley and freestyle; Ed Stone, Tyler Hartles, Tom Page and Daniel Noke (9 yrs) freestyle; Will Moss, Adam Beaumont, Daniel Noke, Tyler Hartles (10 yrs) medley; Laura Cowley, Megan Moss, Poppy McGourlay and Madeleine Hargreaves (10 yrs) medley and freestyle. We also recorded a remarkable 23 2^{nd} places in the individuals and relays. 16 PB's were recorded.

After 28 events, we had a lead of 15 points, but Halesowen fought back to within 5 points after 42 events. Once again, like the first round against Nuneaton, there was one point between the clubs at the start of the last event, the cannon. We gave it our best shot, but Halesowen were just too strong for us, taking maximum points and leaving the teams level-pegging at 243 points in equal 1st place. Our men's open 200m medley relay (Dan Ruckwood, Billy Bott, Paul Wilkes, James Green) and girls' 9/10 yrs medley (Laura Cowley, Megan Moss, Poppy McGourlay and Madeleine Hargreaves) took gold. Both teams came close to the County Championship best performances in their respective events. It was a sweet victory for the girls as earlier in the day, they had been unluckily disgualified for a 'flyer' in the freestyle relav that only the judge had seen. The girls' had snatched 1st place from Halesowen in the last few metres, only to learn they had been deprived of their gold medals. In the masters section for ages 125+ vears, we took four golds and two silvers. Some of the oldies did not want to be outdone by their minors and had squeezed into their new jammers and kneeskins in an attempt to shave off a few tenths of their PBs.
