NUNEATON WINTER 200 & 400 OPEN MEET continued...

Millie Tompkin took gold in the 11/12 yrs 200M breast and swam within the CQT in the 200M IM, 200M & 400M free. Abby Humphreys continued her good run of form taking bronze in the 200M IM and gained her first Midland District qualifying time. Abby swam within a couple of seconds of the MDQT in the 200M free, 200M back (4th place) and 400M IM (4th place). 10 year old, Rebecca Winn also qualified for next year's Midlands in the 200M breast and gained automatic entry into the 100M entry as well. Olga Hall recorded a PB in the 200M back, just 2.5 seconds outside the MDQT along with PB's in the 200M breast, 200M IM & 400M IM. Laura Cowley continued her consistent form by producing 2 PB's and CQT's in the 200M & 400M free and Adam Beaumont, the sole entry from our boys, produced an excellent swim in the 9/10 yrs 200M breast finishing in 5th place and obtaining the CQT.

A much guieter month for competitions in December, but once again our swimmers continued to notch up more County, Midland and National qualifying times.

NUNEATON WINTER 200 & 400 OPEN MEET

A small group of swimmers travelled to the competitive Level 2 meet at The Pingles, Nuneaton during the first weekend of December. The event was specifically for 200 and 400 metres events. Once again our swimmers proved their worth achieving 27 County qualifying times out of 28 swims, along with 3 Midland Poppy McGourlay continued her relentless qualifying times. onslaught on the region's open meets returning home victorious in 3 events in the 9/10 section: 200M free (gaining her second Midland District qualifying time), 400M free and 200M IM, along with 4th place in the 200M back and 6th in the 200M breast. Poppy also recorded PB's in all her swims.

NATIONAL LEAGUE RND 3

A long journey to Hucknall, Nottinghamshire saw the final round of the National League, Division 2. As in previous rounds, the team stepped up to the mark coming home victorious with second-placed local rival, Stratford Sharks 43 points Once again, CQT adrift. were recorded in nearly 100% of the individual events. PLYMOUTH LEANDER OPEN MEET

Our City of Birmingham swimmers braved the pre-Christmas snow and travelled down to one of the country's elite independent schools, Millfield for Plymouth Leander's Level 1 open meet. The meet was held over three days in the school's 50 metre pool. The event was attended by many of the country's top swimmers, some trying to gain qualifying times for the British Championships in March this year.

Two of our swimmers achieved qualifying times for the 2011 ASA National Championships - Caitlin Britt and Dan Ruckwood. Caitlin swam a NQT in the 11/12 yrs 200M breast, winning the silver medal. She then improved on her 2nd place by taking gold in the 100M breast. Dan had previously obtained the National QT for the 100M back, but repeated the achievement in the same event at Millfield.

Other impressive swims came from Lucy Corden 14/15 yrs 100M back 3rd place, 200M back 4th place, Open 50M back 9th place; Dan Ruckwood Open 50M back 3rd place, Open 50M Free 4th place, 17 yrs & over 100M free 9th place; Sophie Bridgman 14/15 yrs 800M free 5th place, 400M free 8th place, 100M fly 8th place; Megan Moss 11/12 yrs 100M breast 8th place; Caitlin Britt 11/13 yrs 100M breast 5th place, 11/12 yrs 200M back 10th place, 200M IM 6th place; Franca Phillips 11/12 yrs 100M back 9th place, 200M free 8th place and 100M free 9th place.
