### WORCESTER COUNTY DEVELOPMENT MEET

The County's annual Development Meet, for 9-12 year-old swimmers, took place on Saturday 1 October at Wolverhampton. ### WORCESTER OPEN MEET

A team of swimmers competed in the Worcester Open Meet between 21-23 October. The first races were the 400m free and 400m IM, held on Four swimmers Friday evening. attended, with Poppy McGourlay and Rebecca Winn both picking up bronze medals in the 11/12 years free and IM events respectively. Twins Josef and Marcus Langmead took part in the boys free event, finishing in 6<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> place respectively.

Saturday 22 October saw more swimmers attending with further medal winners and more CQTs being recorded. Leading the medal haul was 10 year old Daniel Noke who returned home with 6 medals in the 9/10 yrs section (silver 200m IM, 50m fly, 100m back, 200m free, 100m breast, bronze 50m back), Laura Cowley 11/12 yrs silver 50m fly, Zac Gill 13/14 yrs silver 200m IM.
