

Wirral Methodist Circuit Leveque School, Haiti



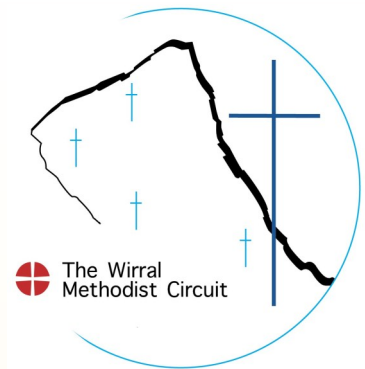
What does our school need? Pupils!!!!!!

The Wirral Methodist Circuit, with generous donations from many other places, has been rebuilding the Leveque Methodist School devastated by the earthquake of January 2010. The building work will be complete and a formal opening will be held in September 2012. But as one of our members found out when she visited in 2011, when she asked what the school would need once completed, "I received a heart wrenching reply - children to attend the school."

School places in Haiti have to be paid for, and in places of poverty like Leveque the choice can be between feeding a family and paying for schooling.

The cost per child works out at US\$ 100 per year (approx. £80 allowing for current fluctuations). This pays for education, uniform, books etc., and they will be fed at least twice a week.

Wirral Circuit has confirmed that it is one of our priorities for maintain the relationship with the school, and will provide the administration to enable a "sponsorship programme" to support the children attending the school and their families.



How will the money get to Haiti?

Funds will be sent via the same international banking system as we have used through the building project.

How much does it cost, and for how long?

The cost in Haiti works out at US\$100 per child per year. This is approximately £80 per year and we suggest you should think in terms of a 5 year commitment. But if you can't afford that much, then donations can be given which will add to the total sponsorships we can offer.

What will the circuit do?

The Circuit will receive the all contributions, bank them and forward them to the school in Haiti. The only costs that the circuit will take from this fund will be flat rate international banking transaction fees.

How will I know the money is supporting the children and their families.

We expect to receive the names of the children being supported by "our" sponsorship.

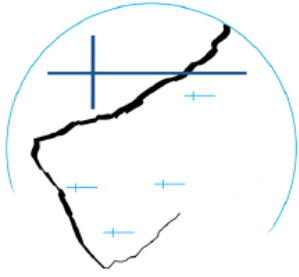
