## PROPOSED SPEED WATCH

Below is a copy of the discussions with PCSO Mc**Keon** 

It looks like we could share Alton's equipment at no cost.

The road itself should be a 30mph zone and you will need a pathway to stand on. If this is not possible a grass verge or driveway can also be used but you must have the owner's permission. If you have a location in mind then let me know and I can do some advanced checks – no point getting everyone signed and vetted if you can't carry out checks in your preferred area!

It seems you could possibly share the kit with Alton scheme as Fourmarks have since purchased their own. I will just have to check they are happy with this.

If you wish to stand alone with a more modern kit the price is roughly 2-3k. You will also need a minimum of 6 members that need to be vetted by Hampshire Constabulary.

The following areas are suggested for consideration.

- 1. Layby at the bottom of Station Road opposite the thatched cottage.
- 2. Outside the Farm Shop.
- 3. By the Village Pond.
- 4. Grass verge opposite Station Cottages.
- 5. Grass verge adjacent to Bridal Close.

All are within the 30mph limit.

## **THE WAY FORWARD**

Before the Police carryout a risk assessment we have to decide if its worth trying to get six people plus a coordinator interested in forming a village Speed Watch.

Once it is determined that we can match the criteria we can then move forward.in requesting the risk assessments and vetting forms.

In the past there has not been much interest, as we can only use Station Road to carry out speed checks.

Determine who is responsible for the grass verges adjacent to Bridal Close and opposite Station Cottages, before an assessment can be carried out.
