What is a Car Club?

A low cost, low emission, low hassle alternative to car ownership.

A community Car Club provides access to a car as and when you need it, without the hassles of ownership. They can save you up to £3,500 per year and benefit the environment.

Car Clubs use low carbon vehicles and members tend to drive fewer miles. This means they can help improve local air quality and cut carbon emissions. (Find out how they work overleaf.)

The Plan...

What is the Plan?

There is a plan to set up a community Car Club in the Mearns area, if enough people are interested.

As fuel prices increase and bus services decline we want to see if there is local interest in a Car Club.

A survey is being carried out by Carplus Trust in partnership with Mearns Area Partnership (MAP) as the first stage in establishing interest in a Car Club in the Mearns area.

To justify establishing an initial pool of 2 or 3 cars we need at least 15 - 20 people (households or business users) to make a commitment to using a shared pool of cars - a Car Club.

What will it cost?

Less than the real cost of owning and maintaining a car!

You need to be over 20 and have at least a year's driving experience.
