The condition of the roads particularly around Denbow and Spain Lane was
yet again raised as an area of concern.

5. **Reports**

Police Report

Chair read out police report from P C Donna Baker . There is to be a new
neighbourhood beat manager on 20/09/10 PC Simon Blythe. The Police
surgeries have been stopped as having held them for 6 months they did not
generate enough interest to continue. incidents reported were 3 non crime
domestic incidents and 7 crimes in the parish including: damage to upstairs
window from air gun pellet; common assault;2 mobile phone thefts; bowser
theft; poultry theft; (full report available from clerk)

District Councillor

Chair read out email report from District Cllr Bob Peachey. “ August has been
a quiet time for meetings at East Devon, I recently attended a meeting which
included a report by D C C officers ref. traffic on the A376 and the A3052
which indicated the main problem on the A3052 occurred at the Clyst St Mary
roundabout and at the motorway junction, the traffic in general on the road
was indicated to be at acceptable levels and is below capacity !!”

Hill Barton Liason Meeting

Cllr A Pearce informed the PC on issues discussed at the recent HB liason
meeting. With regard to the complaints from parishioners re the bad smell
emanating from the fields. The smell was caused by excessively wet sewage
slurry delivered to fields behind Hill Barton. It is covered now, but will smell
again for a few days when spread upon the fields. The sweet smell from the
compost site had been evaluated and its levels are acceptable. Tarmac had

reported that its concrete production is down a third mostly to Uni and Airport. Re the electricity plant – they still had not found any use for the waste heat. Mike Deaton reported to the meeting that the Highways Budget has been cut by 40%. The A3052 corridor study by Jacob's concluded that the Clyst St Mary roundabout was at over capacity in the morning and afternoon rush hour. There is no money for lights. Re the Dark Skies policy A P is to meet with Troy in the Autumn. Also the proposed Farringdon Cross footpath was discussed and if the PC, the landowner and the residents are in agreement then it is a straightforward matter to get it implemented. This would be permitted access not a public right of way. Troy is cutting the hedges along the B3184 next month when he does the other hedging. Crealy Liason Meeting is next month if there are any issues please relate to Cllr A Pearce.

Cllr I Kendall- Torry left the meeting at 8.10pm

County Councillor Report

C Cllr P Bowden apologized for missing the previous meeting. He reported that he spoken recently at DCC that an increase in waste movements resulted in a noise issue. Re the LDF John Maitland is the person to contact for assistance with policy planning . He was aware that the continuing poor state and maintenance of the roads was an ongoing concern. Clerk is to email PC the names of the road Denbow Cross to Axhayes. Also PB requested to be emailed re any fatalities on the A3052

Chair J Smith advised that he had attended the recent Exeter International Airport Consultative Group meeting. Bristol airport will no longer handle the mail this is being handled from Exeter. It will not mean more planes. The Marster plan north and south side has commenced. The Charter business is holding up well and looking relatively good for next year. No announcement yet on the hotel group awarded the contract for the 160 bed hotel. Jamie Christow MD now has 3 airports in the group under his responsibility. Nick Pring (Chair Clyst Honiton) has taken over from Roy Stewart as Chair of the Airport Consultative Group . Farringdon PC Chair J Smith is the vice chair.
