CLASSES COMMENCE 9.30 AM - It is up to competitors to  
allow sufficient time to arrive in time to enter classes.

### Class 1. Novice Ridden - Ridden (Judge Mrs S Fairbank)

Horse not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in any ridden showing class during 2010 or 2011. **There will NOT be a group canter in this class.**  
1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> qualify to enter the 2011 ridden championship class 9.

### Class 2. Best turned out - Ridden (Judge Mrs S Fairbank)

Open to any horse aged 4 and over.

### Class 3. ScotNorth Festival Masterclass - Ridden (Judge J Furness)

**This class is carried over from the Festival at Scone**

Open to any horse aged 4 and over

1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> qualify to enter the 2011 ridden championship class 9 and receive the Peter Monteith Masterclass perpetual trophy.

### Class 4. Showing type ex racehorse - Ridden (Judge Mrs S Johnstone)

Open to any horse aged 4 and over.

Will be judged as showing class for manners, turnout and paces. Individual show to show walk, trot, halt and canter.

1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> qualify to enter the 2011 ridden championship class 9.

*Special award for highest placed horse/rider competing side saddle or Western.*

*Horses entered in the class may not enter class 3.*

### Class 5. Performance type ex racehorse - Ridden (Judge Mrs L Rearie)

Open to any horse aged 4 and over.

Judge will look for a forward going, athletic horse. Class will include TWO jumps height 2ft3 approx. Individual show to show walk, trot, canter and include the jumps on both reins.

**The winner will receive the Roschal Memorial perpetual trophy.**

1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> qualify to enter the 2011 ridden championship class 9.

*Special award for highest placed horse/rider competing side saddle or Western.*

*Horses entered in this class may not enter class 2.*

### Class 6. Best Partnership (Judge Mrs S Fairbank, ScotNorth committee members tbc)

This class focuses on the partnership between horse and rider. It will include some obstacles such as trotting poles, cones, dismounts (planned ones) and re-mounts and all will be made clear on the day ☺

1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> qualify to enter the 2011 ridden championship class 9.

### Class 7. Open In hand (Judge Mr M Johnstone)

Open to any age.

1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> qualify to enter the 2011 ridden championship class 9.

**Classes 8 and 9 are restricted to horses placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in a relevant ScotNorth class during 2011, including today's show. See class 10 below for Veteran qualifier rules.**

### Class 8. 2011 In Hand Championship (Judges Mr M Johnstone, Mrs L Rearie)

**Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Special rosettes 7<sup>th</sup> place onwards.**

### Class 9. 2011 Ridden Championship (Judges Mrs S Fairbank, Mrs S Johnstone)

**Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Special rosettes 7<sup>th</sup> place onwards.**

### Class 10. 2011 Veteran Ridden Championship (Judge Mr M Johnstone, Mrs S Fairbank)

**Open to Horses aged 12 yrs and over, no qualification required for this class as we did not hold enough veteran classes during 2011.**

### Class 11. 2011 Show Supreme Champion and reserve Champion (No entry fee)

**The Supreme Championship is open to all horses placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> at today's show.**

## SCOTNORTH CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW 2011 - information

### The Show

This is the Championship show for 2011. Classes are open to any ScotNorth registered horse. All horses placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> during 2011 (including this show) are eligible for the Championship Classes 8 - 10. **See special qualifier rules for Class 10.**

### The Venue

The venue is **Sandyflat RDA centre, Caldercuilt Road Summerston Glasgow G23 5NA**

### The Judges

The judges are from our approved panel and are well versed with our judging criteria so if your beloved horse has lumps, bumps or scars from racing; or goes best in a 'non showing' bit don't worry, all of these are discounted as part of our judging criteria. We have a mix of judges for the classes, and the Championship classes will be judged by at least 2 judges from the day.

### Eligibility to enter

Horses must be registered with the Scottish & Northern Ex Racehorse Club prior to entry.

As this is a show for amateur riders, professionally produced/ridden horses are not eligible to enter. Horses placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> in any class on the day are eligible to enter the relevant Championship Classes.

There is no stabling or accommodation for this years' show – our apologies.

The Rules and stuff

- Scottish & Northern Ex Racehorse Club, its organising members, the venue and land owners will not be held responsible for loss or damage to any horse, person or property whatsoever.
- You must tidy up after yourself in the lorry park and clear up your horse poo/loose hay etc – thanks. If you don't then the club has to pay a 'clean up fee' which takes money away from better use elsewhere.
- A hard hat to EN1384, PAS015 etc. must be worn and fastened at all times while mounted or showing horses in the arena/warm up area. **Please note, strapless riding hats are not allowed as this invalidates our insurance.**
- **Dogs must not be left in cars or horse boxes.** They are welcome provided they are kept on a lead. Owners must clear up any doggy doos!
- The judge's decision is final!
- Trophies must be signed for and returned at the request of ScotNorth.
- Excessive use of whip, spurs, 'training aids' etc at any time during the day will result in the rider being asked to leave the show.
- ScotNorth may refuse entry and no reason will be provided.
