CENTRAL SCOTLAND HORSE TRIALS 7<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2011

**The Festival**

Following on from the huge success of the first Festival held last year, we are holding to 2011 Festival at Central Scotland Horse Trials. As the club is spread over such a wide geographical area we agreed that the Festival would move each year to ensure all members have the opportunity to attend.

**The Judges**

The classes will be judged by our panel judges who are well versed in our judging criteria.

**Eligibility to enter**

Horses must be registered with the Scottish & Northern Ex Racehorse Club prior to entry. Horses must have raced, or have been in training with a registered trainer for 6 months or more. As this is a show for amateur riders, professionally produced/ridden horses are not eligible to enter.

**Qualifiers**

The classes are qualifiers for the ScotNorth Championship Show – date to be confirmed. 1st to 3rd in each class will qualify for the relevant classes at the annual show.

**The Trophies**

The Masterclass Perpetual Trophy was kindly donated by the late Peter Monteith.

The Veteran Perpetual Trophy.

The In Hand Perpetual Trophy.

The Roschal Memorial Perpetual Trophy has been kindly donated and is sponsored by another of Scotland's top trainers Lucinda Russell.

The Championship trophy is sponsored by David Stevenson of Ashleybank Investments, he is a keen racehorse owner.

**Prizes**

£10 to class winners  
Various other prizes to be awarded

**CLASSES - ENTRY FEE £10.00 PER CLASS. CLASSES COMMENCE AT 14.00**

**Class 1 – ScotNorth Ridden Ex Racehorse Master Class**

**The judge will not ride.**

**Horses must be aged 4 years and over.**

**This is a 'master class' there will be a group canter.**

**Class 2 – ScotNorth Veteran Ex Racehorse**

**The judge will not ride.**

**Horses must be aged 12 and over.**

**Class 3 – ScotNorth In Hand Ex Racehorse**

**Any age. Special rosette to the highest placed Veteran (aged 14 or over)**

**Special Awards**

Roschal memorial Trophy – special rosette and perpetual trophy will be awarded to the horse the judges would most like to take hunting.

Best Rider under 18 - special rosette and prize will be awarded to the best rider aged under 18.

Best Partnership – special rosette and prize will be awarded to the best horse and rider/handler partnership.

Best Turned Out – special rosette and prize will be awarded to the best turned out horse and rider/handler combination.

Best Eventer Type - special rosette and prize will be awarded to the horse and rider combination that the judge feels is the best eventing type.

Horses placed 1st /2nd, and winners of the special awards will come forward to be judged for Champion and Reserve Champion of the Festival.

**Stabling**

There is no stabling available at the event this year.

**The Rules and stuff**

Scottish & Northern Ex Racehorse Club, its organising members, Central Scotland Horse Trials and land owners will not be held responsible for loss or damage to any horse, person or property whatsoever.

A hard hat to EN1384, PAS015 etc. must be worn and fastened at all times while mounted or showing horses in the arena.

Dogs must not be left in cars or horse boxes. They are welcome provided they are kept on a lead. Owners must clear up any doggy doos!

The judge's decision is final!

Trophies must be signed for and returned at the request of Scotnorth.

ScotNorth may refuse entry and no reason will be provided.

LATE ENTRIES will depend on class sizes and will attract an additional fee of £5 per class.
