WELCOME TO VISITORS

Our church is open from approximately dawn to dusk. The beautiful stained-glass windows were made at Buckfast Abbey and the unique 30,000 piece mosaic represents St Paul, as the "scales fell away from his eyes" (Acts, 9:18). The picture above the sanctuary is the now world-famous depiction of the Last Supper by local artist Nicholas St. John Rosse. The statue in the corner is of St Paul Shipwrecked. It is a copy of that in the church of the same name in Valletta, Malta (see Acts, Chapters 27 and 28:1-11). The statue of Our Lady on the right hand side of the altar is of Serpentine stone. Also at the front of the Church in the right hand corner, you will see a reconstituted marble statue of the Holy Family. This statue was presented by 'The Friends of the Holy Family' and blessed by Fr. Bryan. Our church has become a place of pilgrimage.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Some of us may sometimes wonder exactly what the second collection is used for. In the last eleven years Patrick Clarke, our hard-working H&S representative and Fr. Storey have overseen many improvements made to our premises, most as a result of the annual parish check made by the Diocesan H&S executives. Some of them were:

- Rewiring of the entire electrical system
- Treatment of wood worm
- Emergency lighting
- Renewal of the hot water system in the Social Centre
- Upgrading the fire appliances
- Appointment of Dominic Guly as First Aider; First Aid box installed
- Emergency exits and signs
- Disabled parking

In addition, the upper south west wall was cladded to fix a persistent leak and glass doors coated, amongst others.

Thanks to these efforts we have achieved an efficiency rating of 94% (one of the best in the Diocese). Thanks also to Patrick and Fr. Storey for their efforts on our behalf.
