Fri 17 Aug	<b>Self led task:</b> Cutting back overhanging vegetation and encroachment from pathways - ROS.
Fri 24 Aug	<b>idverde led task (SL):</b> Non-native invasive species removal to comply with Natural England and stewardship agreement.
Fri 31 Aug	<b>Self led task:</b> Bracken and low lying scrub regeneration control - Wet Meadows.
