- Walk up Lakes Road for 120m and turn right into Keston Gardens. Take Footpath 303 on the left hand side (between numbers 4 & 5). This path leads to Commonside, next to 'The Greyhound' pub; you may like to take a break here or at 'The Fox' pub nearby.
- Cross over Commonside on to the green. Walk past the water fountain and on to the wooden bar gate on the far side. Immediately after the second gate, turn left and continue on to Baston Road.
- Cross Baston Road and follow the path to the right of the car park. At the junction, take the right hand path and follow it until you reach a second fork. Here, carry straight on to a crossroads, where you turn left and cross over the bridleway. Follow the path as it bends round to the right and on to West Common Road. Cross over and then follow the path round to the left.
- Cross Croydon Road and follow the path straight on until you reach a fork. Take the left hand fork and follow straight on. Continue to follow this path until you reach a crossroads. Turn left and continue straight on until you reach Croydon Road. Cross over towards West Wickham Common, managed by the Corporation of London. Walk down Hartfield Crescent and take the footpath on your left behind the house.
- Here the walk joins the London LOOP. Follow the signs for the LOOP through the woodland. On a clear day you will get some good views of Well Wood, New Addington and Coney Hall. Continue to follow this path straight on and down the hill, following the LOOP signs at all times.
- At the end of the common, cross Gates Green Road and walk to the pedestrian crossing on Croydon Road. After crossing over, turn right up Croydon Road, crossing Coney Hill Road. Turn left when you reach Pole Cat Alley, byway 102 and follow this path till it opens out at the entrance to the Warren. Continue straight on down Warren Wood Close and follow this path back to the start of the walk.

Additional Information...

A 5 mile walk through the commons of Hayes, Keston and West Wickham, plus Ravensbourne Open Space and Padmall Wood.

Short cut from Point 5:


Continue along the path for a short way and you will reach a small meadow area. Cross this and take the right hand path through the woodland on the other side. Follow this path as it bends round to the right. Cross the next meadow area and turn right at the end. This brings you out at Baston Road. Cross over and rejoin the main walk at point 13.

The land surrounding the commons has been farmed and settled for at least 1,200 years. The commons themselves have poor soil and were used for grazing. Since the grazing ceased earlier this century the commons have been colonised by trees.

Starting point: Warren Road, opposite

Station Hill, Hayes.

Distance: 5 miles **Duration:** 3 hours

Short cut route: Point 5 to Point 13

- Turn left here, passing an avenue of hornbeams; note their snake-like bark. Follow this path as it bends round to the left and head towards West Common Road. Cross West Common Road and follow the main path straight ahead for 90m until it forks.
- 3 Keep to the right hand path and follow it round as it bends to the left. Eventually you will cross over the bridleway. A short way after this you will reach Baston Road.
- Cross Baston Road and follow the main path all the way to Croydon Road where there is a row of cottages to the left. Carefully cross Croydon Road and follow the path ahead for 125m.
- To continue on the circular walk take the first path on your left. (As an alternative route you can continue straight ahead and take the short cut see additional information). When you reach the path fork take the right hand path. At the next fork, take the left hand path, and continue for 50m. Follow the path as it bends round to the left. At the next major junction of five paths, take the second left.
- Walk onto Commonside, cross over and enter Padmall Wood through the kissing gate. Cross the grassy area and take the right hand path where it forks. This coppiced woodland consists mainly of sweet chestnut and birch trees. The former is an extremely useful fencing timber and is still harvested today. In 1275 William Pessum makes mention of a water mill at 'Padmille'. Continue following this main path, past a small bridge on the left until you reach a T-junction.
