Councillors agreed to a number of actions to help address the situation. Keith Weston from the National Trust spoke following the public meeting the previous evening concerning the car park proposals at Barrington Court – 43 members of the public attended. Councillors agreed a grant to the Little Levels Pre-School (Barrington). A planning application at The Lilacs, Silver Street was considered – there were no objections.
