SUMMARY OF THE OCTOBER MEETING: Keith Weston from the National Trust addressed the meeting on the car park plans for Barrington Court. The planning application for this is about to be submitted and will probably be considered at the November Parish Council meeting. The opening event for the Outdoor Fitness Equipment took place on Saturday 29th September and was well attended by 40-50 people. The Royal Mail & The Trading Standards Office are making people aware of the following scam: a card is passed through your door from a company called PDS (Parcel Delivery Service) suggesting that they were unable to deliver a parcel and that you need to contact them on 0906 6611911 (A Premium rate number!) ***If you call this number and start to hear a recorded message you will already have been billed £315 for the phone call.***

If you do receive a card with these details, then please contact Royal Mail Fraud on 020 7239 6655. For more information see the Crime Stoppers website: www.crimestoppers-uk.org.

Please be aware that the premium rate number may change but nevertheless please do not call any number on a card from PDS.
