Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Do I have to own my own instrument?

A. No. We provide the instrument

Q. Must I be able to read music?

A. No, but it will help you learn faster

Q. I'm a beaver - Can I join?

A. I'm sorry but band membership is only open to people 8 years upwards.

Q. Do I need to be a member of either of the two Fareham Scout Districts?

A. No. As long as you're prepared to travel, we're prepared to accept you into the band

Q. Do I have to buy another uniform?

A. No. Where possible the band will provide you with the parade uniform, but you will be expected to buy our grey practice tops (Fleece and T-Shirt)

Parades & Workshops

*An annual capitation fee may also be payable by members not currently in a scout group.
