#### Dear Friends

The Christmas lights are on with snowmen, candles and reindeers, we are updated on the TV how many shopping days it is till Christmas, and after looking through the Aldi Food catalogue – it's not only the geese that will be getting fat this month There has been serious talk of changing the name from Christmas to Winter Holiday. ! Is this really where we are as a country?

We have absolutely no certainty of the date of Jesus' birth, or even the year – although many speculate with differing theories. But does that really matter? The reality of Christmas is ageless and eternal.

The truth is that we were a people who did not know God. The real meaning of 'gentile' is pagan. We knew nothing of God's grace and glory which has been manifest in His relationship with Israel over 4000 years. (A little comment that puts this into focus comes from a conversation between the future President of the re-established State of Israel, Chaim Weizmann and ex-PM Lord Balfour. Balfour had suggested that land was given to the Jews to make a state in Uganda. Weizmann replied 'Mr Balfour, supposing I were to offer you Paris instead of London, would you take it?' 'But, Dr Weizmann, we have London,' said Balfour. 'True, but we had Jerusalem', replied Weizmann, 'when London was a marsh.')

The reality is that two thousand years ago in the very heart of Israel, on the hills of Judea south of Jerusalem, a child was born who was destined from before time began to be the Saviour of the world.

The birth of this baby Yeshua, who we acknowledge as Jesus, and own as our Lord and King, was born in a humble Bethlehem home built around a cave, with the animals nearby. All the spare rooms in the village were already filled with other families coming back to their home roots to register for the census. There is so much we can meditate on in the obedience and trust of Mary and Joseph. Then, out in the fields, shepherds were broken off from guarding their sheep by the appearance of an angel radiating the glory of God. He told them not to fear, he told them of good tidings of great joy for ALL people, a Saviour has been born – and they can go to see him back in Bethlehem. Then came the wonderful angelic chorus singing "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will towards men". I wonder what those indescribable harmonies sounded like. One day we trust we will hear them for ourselves.

I have often wondered about how this experienced ended for the shepherds. Lk 2:17-18 says "When they had seen him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child, and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them." Can you imagine them going through the village and possibly further afield saying "Have you heard the news, the Saviour, the Messiah has been born, God cares, He's been born as a little baby. The angel told us and we have been to see Him, and it's true". So what about you and me? Are we sharing this news this Christmas?

The angels still give this invitation Come now to Bethlehem and see the child The Son of God's been born as a baby Revealing God's heart of Love for mankind So let's draw close and kneel at the manger And gaze upon this Holy infant king As our hearts sense again the awE and the wonder Lets join with the host of heaven and sing Glory, Glory to God in the highest Peace on earth and good will towards all men

## WHY WASPS?

All things have a purpose What on earth can wasps be for? Pam Ayres



This question was posed by my neighbour who saw me tending my beans which were growing in front of a wasp's nest housed in an air brick.

Throwing up his hands in horror, he pointed out that I had two wasps' nests (I actually had three), saying kill them before they sting you. However, after I'd said that the wasps were welcome to stay, that they would not harm me as long as I did not threaten them, his rejoinder was to ask "Why are they here, what good are they?, they're no good for anything and they do nothing but sting". Well they do quite a lot actually. They may pollinate flowers, and may be pest and biological controllers.

Do you like figs? I do, but without a certain species of wasp specifically adapted to pollinate fig flowers, and no other insect is adapted to do this, the fig tree could not complete its life cycle therefore we would not have figs.

Social wasps are predators; some species prey upon other insects thus helping keep down the pest population by eating the larvae and adult insects of harmful pests. Some farmers have been known to introduce wasps deliberately to control insects injurious to their crops, in much the same way as gardeners use nematodes( parasitic worms) to control slugs, weevils sawflies etc. Pam Ayres, like my neighbour, asks what on earth can wasps be for, but my question is what can we be for, or why are we here? The answer may be found in the following phrases taken from Creation Jazz written by Pat Rooke.

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

"Let there be land. Let there be seas.

Let there be grasses and we must have some trees.

Let there be herbs- - - Let there be riches contained in the Seas- - -"

- - - But nowhere in that painted world was a living creature seen.

Gonna tell you how the great Lord God made the fish, the beasts and the birds

He told the salmon to 'leap' the crab to creep, --- the howling dog and the snake that sleeps ----

Birds and beasts of every kind were part of God's great plan One thing still was missing - And that was man.

Nobody there to dig the land - - - No-one to plough ---. God said "I've given birth to ev'rything upon this earth Now I must make a man of worth"...
